

Thursday Nov 24th Commences with a light breeze from
E. S. E. and fine pleasant weather the ship
heading S. by E. sails the mizzen employed in
ships duty Middle part the same
Latter part heading S. by E. the mizzen
employed in ships duty Lat 15° 22' N. Long 39° 15' W.

Friday Nov 25th Light wind and pleasant weather
heading S. by E. saw a Pin back
Middle and Latter part the same
Lat 16° 44' N. Long 44° 14' W.

Saturday Nov 26th Light wind and pleasant weather
heading S. by E. with all sail out and employed
in various ways Middle and Latter part heading
S. by E. Lat 18° 35' N. Long 45° 25' W.

Sunday Nov 27th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading S. by E. with all sail out Middle part
a strong breeze heading S. by E. Latter part
the same Lat 15° 51' N. Long 46° 56' W.

Monday Nov 28th Commences with a fresh breeze and pleasant
weather heading S. by E. Middle part the same
Latter part the wind very light the ship heading
S. by E. saw a sail all hands employed on
the rigging Lat 15° 55' N. Long 41° 39' W.

Tuesday Nov 29th Light wind and fine pleasant weather
the ship heading S. E. with all sail out all hands
employed getting the rigging at 4 p.m. lowered
all the boats to exercise our green hands one
sail in sight Middle part the same Latter part
employed setting up the head stays
Lat 16° 57' N. Long 40° 56' W.

Wednesday Nov 30th Light wind and fine pleasant weather
heading S. E. employed setting up the head stays
Middle part the same Latter part employed in
various ways Lat 15° 22' N. Long 39° 15' W.

Thursday Dec 1st

Commences with a strong breeze and squally
weather the ship heading from S. to S. E. employed
setting up the fore rigging Middle part very
squally with plenty of rain and thunder and lightning
took in the top gallant sails jib and gaff top
sail Latter part much the same one sail in
sight Lat 16° 57' N. Long 38° 45' W.

Friday Dec 2nd Commences with a strong breeze and squally
weather with a rugged sea heading S. by E. one sail
in sight Middle and Latter part the same
Lat 10° 53' N. Long 38° 08' W.

Saturday Dec 3rd Strong wind and rugged the ship
heading S. E. by S. set the main top gallant
sail Middle and Latter part the same

Sunday Dec 4th Commences with a strong breeze and dark
cloudy weather heading S. E. by S. passed a ship
which showed French Colours steering about N. E. W.
Middle and Latter part the wind light
Lat 15° 42' N. Long 38° 57' W.

Monday Dec 5th Light wind and squally heading S. E.
with all sail out Middle part took in the
top gallant sails and jib - Latter part at half
past 10 a.m. tacked ship heading E. S. E.
Lat 6° 52' N. Long 34° 55' W.
