E. E. Latter part had some heavy squalls with plenty of rain bent the jib. Lat. 2. 37. N. Long. 35. 11. W.

Friday Dec. 16th Light wind and pleasant weather heading from S. by W. to S. E. by E. employed in various ways Middle part a fresh breeze heading S. by W. Latter part much the same employed getting on the fore top gallant mast and set up the rigging. Lat. 2. 43. N. Long. 31. 01. W.

Saturday Dec. 17th Light wind and pleasant weather heading S. by W. all hands employed in various ways Middle part tacked ship heading E. by S. Latter part the same employed sending up the fore top gallant yard and set up a brigg standing to the S. W. Lat. 3. 02. S. Long. 30. 15. W.

Sunday Dec. 18th Commenced with a fresh breeze and cloudy weather heading E. by N. all hands employed in various ways at sunset tacked Ship heading S. W. by S. Middle part tacked E. by N. had some squalls of wind and rain. Latter part the same no Obs.

Monday Dec. 19th Commenced with a light air and rain the Ship heading S. E. Middle part heading E. Latter part steering S. and very rainy no Obs.

Tuesday Dec. 20th Commenced with a moderate breeze and rainy weather heading S. Middle part light wind and clear. Latter part had some squalls of rain, ended with clear weather. Lat. 2. 19. N. Long. 30. 38. W.

Wednesday Dec. 21th Commenced with a light S. E. breeze and clear pleasant weather heading S. W. the watch employed in various ways. Middle part heading S. W. by S. Latter part the same all hands employed getting the rigging. Lat. 1. 35. N. Long. 31. 15. W.

Thursday Dec. 22nd Light wind and squally heading from S. W. by S. by W. all hands employed in various ways, at half past 3 p. m. tacked Ship heading E. Middle part tacked Ship heading S. S. W. Latter part much the same employed getting the rigging. Lat. 00. 51. N. Long. 31. 45. W. called a Porpoise.

Friday Dec. 23rd Light wind and pleasant weather heading S. W. by S. and S. S. W. employed rattling down the fore rigging and in various other jobs, at sunset tacked a Dolphin. Middle part heading S. by W. Latter part heading S. S. W. employed rattling down the main rigging. Lat. 00. 31. N. Long. 32. 13. W.
