

Saturday Dec. 24th Light wind and pleasant weather heading from S. W. by E. to S. E. W. all hands employed in the rigging. Middle and Latter part strong breeze heading S. S. W. employed in the hold. Lat. 2° 32' S. Long. 33° 13' W.

Sunday Dec. 25th Commences with a strong breeze and pleasant weather heading S. S. W. saw a Sail employed in the hold. Middle part at Midnight tacked to the N. E. at 3 o'clock tacked back again at Sundown saw the Island Ferdinand Noronah bearing S. S. W. Latter part passed the Island to the Westward at 12 o'clock it bore S. E. by E.

Monday Dec. 26th Strong wind and pleasant weather heading S. S. W. Middle part and Latter part the same heading S. W. by E. saw a Sail. Lat. 5° 42' S. Long. 33° 54' W.

Tuesday Jan. 1st Strong wind and galled heading S. W. by E. the watch employed in various ways. Middle part made a short tack to the E. Latter part heading S. by W. saw the Coast of South America and 2 sails. Lat. 7° 11' S. Long. 34° 31' W.

Wednesday Jan. 2nd Light wind and squally heading S. W. the Coast of South America in sight. saw 2 sails. The watch employed in ship duty at half past 5 p. m. tacked ship heading E. N. E. Middle part tacked ship heading S. S. W. Latter part much the same, the Coast of South America in sight. Lat. 1° 54' S. a number of sails in sight

Thursday Dec. 28th Commences with a light breeze and fine pleasant weather heading S. W. by E. at 2 p. m. passed German buoy, a number of sails in sight. the watch employed in various ways. Middle part strong breeze steering S. by E. Latter part much the same employed in various ways. Lat. 10° 05' S. Long. 34° 46' W.

Friday Dec. 30th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering S. by E. employed in various ways. Middle part the same, passed a sail. Latter part heading S. half W. employed painting the waist boat and in various other ways saw 2 sails. Lat. 11° 18' S. Long. 34° 34' W.

Saturday Dec. 31st Light breeze and fine pleasant weather heading S. half W. employed taring down rigging one sail in sight. Middle part steering S. Latter part the same pointed the bow boat 2 sails in sight. Lat. 14° 11' S. Long. 34° 36' W.

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Sunday Jan. 1st Commences with a light breeze and pleasant weather steering S. by E. at half past 4 p. m. spoke the Brigg Tybston of Santa Cruz. Cpt. Price 56 days from home see list. Middle part steering S. by E. Latter part the same spoke the Tybston again. Lat. 16° 07' S. Long. 34° 46' W.

Monday Jan. 2nd Commences with a fresh breeze from S. E. steering S. by E. in company with the Tybston. Middle part steering S. S. W. Latter part the same, saw a number of sails. Lat. 18° 13' S.
