

Friday Jan 13th Commenced with a strong wind and very
rugged with some rain, steering S. W. at 4 p. m.
took in the fore top sail and main sail
and close reefed the main top sail. Middle
part the same. Latter part the wind hauled
to the S. the ship heading E. & E.

Saturday Jan 14th Commenced with a moderate Gale from the
S. the ship heading E. & E. with all prudent sail
out. Middle part were ship heading W. & W.
Latter part heading N. employed bunking out for
various things. Lat. 34° 48' S. Long. 51° 34' W.

Sunday Jan 15th Commenced with a light breeze from
S. & W. the ship heading W. employed in the
hold, at 6 p. m. bore ship heading S. E. by E.
Middle part the same. Latter part steering S. & W.
with a strong breeze one sail in sight
Lat. 35° 44' S. Long. 51° 32' W.

Monday Jan 16th Light wind and pleasant weather
steering S. W. by S. at 2 p. m. spoke the Bark
Atlantic of New Bedford Capt. Luce
26 months out 1000 bbls. sperm. - Middle
part strong wind, double reefed the top sails
steering S. W. - Latter part it blowed a
moderate Gale took in the main sail, jib
and spanker. Lat. 37° 24' S. - Long. 53° 21' W.

Tuesday Jan 17th Commenced with a moderate Gale from
N. W. and hazy weather, steering S. W. half S.
Middle part took in all sail but the close
reefed main top sail, plenty of Thunder and
lightning. Latter part the wind hauled to the
S. the ship heading E. by S.

Wednesday Jan 18th Commenced with a Gale from the S.
and E. wore ship heading W. by S. under close
reefed main top sail and fore sail - Middle
part heading E. - Latter part heading W. by N.
Lat. 39° 50' S. - Long. 54° 41' W.

Thursday Jan 19th Commenced with a Gale from
S. and W. the ship heading S. by E. under
close reefed main top sail - Middle and Latter
part the same - Lat. 40° 44' S. Long. 54° 06' W.

Friday Jan 20th Commenced with a strong Gale from
the S. and W. lying too under close reefed
main top sail with a heavy sea running.
Ends much the same. Lat. 40° 00' S. - Long. 54° 51' W.

Saturday Jan 21st more moderate but very rugged, wore
ship heading W. by N. set double reefed top sails
and fore sail - Middle part the wind very
light and set all sail - Latter part it blowed
a Gale again, took in all sail but the close
reefed main top sail and fore sail, steering S. W.
Lat. 42° 00' S. - Long. 54° 40' W.

Sunday Jan 22nd Commenced with a moderate Gale from
N. W. steering S. W. at 2 p. m. set the close
reefed fore top sail, at 6 p. m. set the main
sail. Middle part took in the main sail
and fore top sail - Latter part the wind
very light and set all sail
Lat. 43° 13' S. - Long 55° 22' W.
