

Monday Jan. 23rd Commences with a light breeze from the N. steering S. W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W. with thick hazy weather. Middle part a fresh breeze. Latter part strong wind, double reefed the top sails a number of Fin backs in sight.
Lat. $43^{\circ} 50'$ S. - Long $57^{\circ} 24'$ W.

Tuesday Jan. 24th Commences with a strong wind and very rugged, heading W. with double reefed top sails employed in various ways, at 4 p.m. wore ship, heading S. by E. saw a fin back. Middle part it blew a strong Gale, took in all sail but the close reefed main top sail and mizen stay sail. Latter part more moderate, set the close reefed fore top sail main sail and fore sail. Lat. $44^{\circ} 08'$ S. Long $57^{\circ} 03'$ W.

Wednesday Jan. 25th Commences with a strong wind and very rugged, heading S. S. E. with all prudent sail out. Middle part the wind hauled to the N. spread all sail steering S. S. W. at daylight the wind increased to a heavy Gale took in all sail but the close reefed main top sail and luffed to the wind heading W. by N. - Latter part very rugged, stove the waist boat, took her and the bow boat in on deck. Lat. $45^{\circ} 32'$ S. - Long $57^{\circ} 30'$ W.

Thursday Jan. 26th Commenced with a strong Gale from the N. and very rugged, heading W., at 5 p.m. it moderated, set the fore sail, saw a fin back. Middle and Latter part the same.
Lat. $46^{\circ} 02'$ S. Long $57^{\circ} 05'$ W.

Friday Jan. 27th Commences with a strong wind and very rugged heading S. by E. - Middle part the same. Latter part quite moderate shook the reefs out the top sails, at 11 a.m. it blew up a Gale again, took in all sail but double reefed top sail and fore sail - no Obs.

Saturday Jan. 28th Commences with a Gale from the N. steering W. S. W., close reefed the main top sail and furled the fore top sail, at 4 p.m. set the close reefed fore top sail and furled the fore sail and wore ship heading W. N. W. at sunset took in the fore top sail. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. $46^{\circ} 58'$ S. Long $58^{\circ} 24'$ W.

Sunday Jan. 29th Commences with a Gale from S. W. and very rugged, heading W. N. W. Middle part more moderate, set the main sail, jibb and shankar, at 11 o'clock wore ship heading S. by W. Latter part spread all sail, steering S. W. by S. with the wind from N. W. - Lat. $47^{\circ} 06'$ S. Long $59^{\circ} 32'$ W.

Monday Jan. 30th Commences with a fine breeze from the N. W. steering S. W. by W. with all sail out. Middle and Latter part light wind and foggy one sail in sight. Lat. $48^{\circ} 10'$ Long $62^{\circ} 38'$ W.

Tuesday Jan. 31st Commences with a light breeze from N. W. and foggy steering S. W., at 5 p.m. spoke the ship Spreadwell of Fairhaven, Capt Gibbs 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ months out 80 bls sperm - Middle part calm with a thick fog - Latter part it cleared up with a light variable breeze, steering S. W. $\frac{1}{2}$ S. one sail in sight.
Lat. $49^{\circ} 02'$ S. Long $63^{\circ} 20'$ W.
