

Sunday March 26th Light wind and thick foggy weather heading E. N. E., 2 Sail and the Coast of Chili in sight, saw humpbacks and some Blackfish, lowered a boat but without success at half past 2 p.m. tacked ship, heading N. N. W. spoke the Bark Winslow of New Bedford 22 miles out sea 800 sp. and 150 blb. by 10. Middle part Latter part calm and foggy

Lat. 21° 26' N.

Monday March 27th Commences with calm and a thick fog Middle part it cleared up with a breeze from the S., hoisted a bark. the Main top sail - Latter part steered N. E. by E & E. 2 Sails in sight

Tuesday March 28th Commences with a breeze from the S. and thick foggy weather standing off and on of the land, heading various courses Middle part going to - Latter part saw Black fish lowered but got none -

Wednesday March 29th Light wind and thick foggy weather layd with the main top sail aback at half past 1 p.m. it cleared up, saw the land and steered in for Talcahuano, at 7 p.m. came to Anchor of Talcahuano 24 whalers in port - Latter part employed breaking up

Thursday March 30th Employed in various ways breaking out our Bread and flour and coopersing it

Friday March 31st Very stormy, was not able to do any thing

Saturday April 1st Employed breaking out Bread and Flour and coopersing it, and stowing it back again

Sunday April 2nd The starboard watch went on liberty

Monday April 3rd Very rainy with a strong wind from the S. by E. the barometer 30.0

Tuesday April 4th The weather much the same with the starboard watch on liberty

Wednesday April 5th Commences with rainy weather, the starboard watch on liberty - Latter part fine weather, employed in the hold

Thursday April 6th Fine pleasant weather, commenced painting the ship - Latter part finished painting the starboard side

Friday April 7th Took a raft on shore and commenced taking off water

Saturday April 8th Fine pleasant weather got all our water on board and employed in the hold and painting ship

Sunday April 9th Fine pleasant weather finished painting ship and stowed some water - Latter part the starboard watch went on liberty

Monday April 10th Pleasant weather the starboard watch on liberty - Latter part employed in various ways

Tuesday April 11th Pleasant weather, got some Potatoes on board - Latter part employed in various ways
