

Tuesday April 12th Employed in getting of our recruits Latter part employed in various ways

Thursday April 13th Waiting for a breeze to get under way Latter part at 10 a.m. the Capt. came on board and got under way.

Friday April 14th Commenced with a light breeze and pleasant weather, steering N. W. by W. with all sail out & sails in sight - Middle and Latter part calm and foggy

Saturday April 15th Commenced with a calm and thick fog - Middle part a light breeze, steering N. W. Latter part the same

Sunday April 16th Light wind and hazy, heading N. N. W. lowered for some hump backs but got none - Middle part it showed a whale from the N., took in all sail but the close reefed main top sail - Latter part it moderated, wore ship and under sail heading N. N. E. - Lat. 35° 10' S.

Monday April 17th Strong wind and thick cloudy weather heading N. N. E., at 3 p.m. wore ship, heading W. by S. Middle part very rainy heading W. S. W. - Latter part wore ship heading N. N. E. - Lat. 35° 06' S. Long. 75° 50' W.

Tuesday April 18th Strong wind and rugged heading N. N. E. at sunset wore ship heading W. S. W. - Middle part had a thunder storm and steered N. N. W. Latter part much the same. Lat. 34° 14' S. Long. 75° 20' W.

Wednesday April 19th Light wind and pleasant weather heading N. N. W. - Middle part the wind from the E. steering N. W. Latter part the same, employed mending the mizen stay sail. Lat. 33° 21' S. Long. 76° 12' W.

Thursday April 20th Light wind and pleasant weather, steering N. W. by S. with all sail out, employed in various ways - Middle and Latter part the same Lat

Friday April 21th Light wind and fine pleasant weather heading N. W. by S. employed in various ways. Middle part heading from N. to N. N. W. Latter part the same. Lat. 31° 30' S. Long. 76° 47' W.

Saturday April 22nd Light wind and pleasant weather heading from N. to N. N. W. - Middle part steering N. W. by S. & S. - Latter part the same Lat. 30° 12' S. Long.

Sunday April 23rd Light wind and pleasant weather steering N. W. by S. & S., saw Blackfish, lowered the boats and got one - Middle part the same Latter part saw sperm Whales, lowered and got one



Monday April 24th Strong wind and pleasant weather the boats in chase after the whales but with not success - Middle part lured by the whale - Latter part commenced cutting

Tuesday April 25th Finished cutting and cleared up the deck. Middle part commenced boiling Ends the same. Lat. 26° 56' S.
