

Wednesday April 26th Strong wind and rugged
employed boiling Middle part the same.
Latter part saw the William & Henry of
New Bedford chasing a whale

Thursday April 27th Strong wind and very rugged
the ship being for S. W. employed boiling
Middle part finished boiling - Latter part cleared
up and washed off deck. Lat. 26° 54' S.
Long. 82° 12' W.

Friday April 28th Strong wind and rugged steering
N. W. by N. at sunset huffed to the wind
and hauled back heading S. W. - Latter part
steering N. by S. at 10 a.m. saw the island St.
Ambrose

Saturday April 29th Strong wind and fair weather, steering
N. at sunset spoke the Bark Station of
New Bedford - Middle part made all sail and
steered N. W. by N. - Latter part the same
employed breaking out for hoops. Lat 25° 03' S

Sunday April 30th Strong breeze and dark cloudy weather
steering N. W. by N. with all sail out - Middle
and Latter part the same. No Obs.

Monday May 1st Strong breeze and squally steering N. N. by N.
Middle and Latter part the same, one sail in
sight. Lat 20° 19' S.

Tuesday May 2nd Strong wind and squally steering N. W.
by N. at 1 p.m. saw sperm whales, lowered and
struck one, turned the boat over and had
to make with the ship William & Henry
of New Bedford - Middle part kept close
by the William & Henry - Latter part the
Capt. with the boat crew went on board the V. M. S.
after our share of the Whales, employed in various
ways about the ship. Lat. 19° 52' S.

Wednesday May 3rd Light breeze with squalls, at 2 p.m. the
boat came on board with the whale's head and a
blanket piece went to work and took in on deck
Middle part employed clearing up the deck
Latter part commenced boiling

Thursday May 4th Light wind and pleasant weather
employed boiling. the ship heading to the
N. E. one sail in sight - Middle and Latter
employed boiling. Lat 18° 57' S. Long. 82° 53' W.

Friday May 5th Light wind and pleasant weather
heading S. W., one sail in sight, finished
boiling - Middle part heading S. W. - Latter
part steering N. W. - Lat. 18° 56' S. - Long. 83° 52' W.

Saturday May 6th Light wind and pleasant weather
steering N. W. Middle and Latter part calm

Sunday May 7th Commenced with a calm, employed
coopering oil - Middle and Latter part a light
breeze, steering N. N. W. Lat 17° 47' S.
