

Saturday May 20th Light wind and pleasant weather
steering W., spoke the Garland of New Bedford
Middle part stored W. & N. - Latter part the
same saw some Fin backs. Lat. 1° 42' N.
Long. 97° 43' W.

Sunday May 21st Light wind and pleasant weather
steering W. & N. - Middle part the same
Latter part saw sperm whales, lowered 3 boats
and got one

Monday May 22nd Light wind and pleasant weather
took the whale along side and cut him in
Middle part stored W. till 12 o'clock and
then hauled a back heading S. W. - Latter
part stored W., employed clearing away the
whale's head and cutting up the blubber
Lat. 2° 33' N. - Long. 101° 28' W.

Tuesday May 23rd Light breeze and pleasant
weather, steering W. & S. - Middle part the
same - Latter part a strong breeze, commenced
bailing. Lat. 3° 01' N. - Long. 105° 00' W.

Wednesday May 24th Strong wind and clear
steering W. & S. employed bailing - Middle
part finished bailing - Latter part the
same. Lat. 3° 21' N. - Long. 107° 48' W.

Thursday May 25th Strong wind and clear, steering
W. & S. - Middle part the same - Latter
part employed in the hold shifting the
fresh water in the ground tier
Lat. 3° 41' N.

Friday May 26th Strong wind and squally, heading
W., employed in the hold - Middle part
steering W. N. W. - Latter part employed in
the hold. no Obs.

Saturday May 27th Strong wind and dark squally
weather, steering N. W. - Middle and Latter
part rainy, no Obs.

Sunday May 28th Light breeze and very rainy
steering N. W. - Middle and Latter part dark
cloudy weather with some rain. Lat. 8° 49' N.
Long. 115° 22' W.

Monday May 29th Strong wind from the S. and W.
heading N. W. by N., with squalls of rain
Middle and Latter part much the same
with thunder and lightning. no Obs.

Tuesday May 30th Strong wind and very squally
with thunder and lightning and a head
beat sea - Middle part the wind light
steering N. W. by W. - Latter part strong wind
from the E. steering N. W. by N.
Lat. 11° 43' N.
Long. 117° 33' W.

Wednesday May 31st Strong wind and rugged steering
N. W. by N. - Middle part strong breeze from
N. E. - Latter part much the same and
very rugged. Lat. 14° 01' N.
Long. 118° 25' W.
