

Friday July 7th Light breeze and pleasant weather, heading to the N. W., employed boiling - Middle part the same - Latter part finished boiling. Lat. 21° 54' N. Long. 109° 11' W.

Saturday July 8th Light air and calm heading N. W. employed in the hold, saw the John H. Parker Middle part the same - Latter part heading to the S. employed in the hold. Lat. 21° 58' N. Long. 109° 06' W.

Sunday July 9th Light air and pleasant weather heading to the N. E., employed in the hold - Middle part the same - Latter heading N. by W. Lat. 22° 19' N. Long. 109° 06' W.

Monday July 10th Light breeze and pleasant weather heading to the S. and W. - Middle part calm Latter part light breeze, heading W. by S., employed in the hold. Lat. 21° 44' N. Long. 109° 30' W.

Tuesday July 11th Light breeze and pleasant weather, heading W. S. W., finished stowing off the hold and washed ship - Middle part the same - Latter part heading to the N. Lat. 21° 42' N. Long. 109° 51' W.

Wednesday July 12th Light breeze and pleasant weather heading N. by W., at Sunset saw the land and took in sail - Middle part the same Latter part made sail heading to the N. W. Lat. 22° 18' N.

Thursday July 13th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering N. by W., at 2 p. m. saw sperm whales lowered and got 2, took them a long side and cut them in, Middle part employed clearing away the heads - Latter part commenced boiling

Friday July 14th Light breeze and pleasant weather heading in for the land employed boiling, at Sunset took in sail and wore ship - Middle part finished boiling - Latter part made sail, heading to the N. W. Lat. 22° 19' N. Long. 109° 38' W.

Saturday July 15th Light breeze and pleasant weather heading W. N. W., the land in sight, employed repairing the foreboard boat and in various other ways, at Sunset took in sail and tacked ship heading S. W. - Middle part the same Latter part heading to the N. E., saw sperm whales, lowered and got 4

Sunday July 16th Commenced with a fresh breeze and pleasant weather, employed getting the whales along side and cut in 2 - Middle part layd by the whales - Latter part finished cutting one sail in sight

Monday July 17th Light breeze and pleasant weather cleared away the heads and commenced boiling Middle part the same - Latter part heading to the N. W.
