

Tuesday July 18th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading to the N. and W. employed boiling
Middle and Latter part the same - Lat. 22° 29'
Long. 109° 22'

Wednesday July 19th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading to the N. and W. finished boiling
and cleared up the deck - Middle part the same
Latter part employed in the hold. Lat. 22° 26'
Long. 109° 39'

Thursday July 20th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading to the N. W., employed in the hold and
setting up Shooks, at Sunset tacked Ship, heading
S. W. by S. - Middle part the same - Latter
part employed stowing oil.

Friday July 21st Strong breeze and pleasant weather
employed stowing oil, one sail in sight - Middle
and Latter part the same. Lat. 22° 32' N.
Long. 110° 32' W.

Saturday July 22nd Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading E. by N. at Sunset took in sail
and kept her S. by E. - Middle and Latter
part the same. Lat. 22° 31' N.
Long. 109° 55' W.

Sunday July 23rd Light air and calm, heading
all points in the compass - Middle part a
light breeze, steering S. 1/2 W. - Latter part
calm, one sail in sight. Lat. 22° 12'
Long. 109° 49'

Monday July 24th Commences with a calm - Middle part
the same - Latter part a light breeze heading
S. N. W., one sail in sight. Lat. 21° 17'
Long. 109° 37'

Tuesday July 25th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading S. N. W. at 5 p. m. spoke the schooner
R. Parker, at Sunset tacked Ship heading
S. W. Middle part the same - Latter
much the same. Lat. 21° 48' N. Long. 110° 26' W.

Wednesday July 26th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading S. by E. - Middle and Latter part much
the same. Lat. 22° 13'

Thursday July 27th Light breeze and pleasant weather
steering S. E., at half past 5 p. m. saw sperm
whales and got one - Middle part got ready to
cut the whale in - Latter part cut in the
whale and commenced boiling. Lat. 22° 11' N.
Long. 109° 58' W.

Friday July 28th Commences with a calm, employed boiling
Middle part the same - Latter part finished
boiling.

Saturday July 29th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading to the S. W., at Sunset tacked to the N.
Middle and Latter part much the same
Lat. 22° 29' N.
Long. 109° 46' W.
