

Sunday July 30<sup>th</sup> Commences with a fresh breeze and pleasant weather heading to the S. W.  
Middle and Latter part heading to the N.  
Lat. 22° 05' N.  
Long. 109° 49' W.

Monday Aug. 31<sup>st</sup> Light wind and pleasant weather, heading S. W. - Middle and Latter part much the same. Lat. 22° 22' N. Long. 109° 44' W.

Tuesday Aug. 1<sup>st</sup> Light air and pleasant weather, heading to the N. - Middle part heading S. W. - Latter part tacked ship heading N., employed stowing oil. Lat. 22° 15' N. Long. 110° 03' W.

Wednesday Aug. 2<sup>nd</sup> Strong breeze and fair weather, heading N., employed in the hold, at sunset tacked ship heading S. W., one sail in sight - Middle part the same - Latter part stered N. E. Lat. 22° 22' N. Long. 110° 23' W.

Thursday Aug. 3<sup>rd</sup> Light air and pleasant weather, stering N. E. by E. - Middle part layd a back - Latter part calm. Lat. 22° 11' N. Long. 110° 07' W.

Friday Aug. 4<sup>th</sup> Light air and pleasant weather stering N. E. by E., saw Blackfish. Middle part hauled a back the main top sail. Latter part stered S. S. W., one sail in sight. Lat. 21° 40' N. Long. 110° 12' W.

Saturday Aug. 5<sup>th</sup> Strong breeze and pleasant weather heading N. N. E., spoke the Sh. John H. Parker Middle part heading W. P. W. - Latter part tacked ship heading E. N. E., at 9 a.m. saw sperm whales, lowered and got one



Sunday Aug. 6<sup>th</sup> Light air and fair, employed taking the whale alongside and cut him in - Middle part commenced boiling - Latter part the same. Lat. 21° 41' N. Long. 109° 44' W.

Monday Aug. 7<sup>th</sup> Light air and pleasant, heading to the N., the John H. Parker in sight, finished boiling - Middle part the same - Latter part the John H. Parker set a signal for whales, lowered but got none, she got one. Lat. 22° 19' N. Long. 109° 33' W.

Tuesday Aug. 8<sup>th</sup> Light air and pleasant, heading to the N. W. - Middle part saw a steamer - Latter part heading to the N., at 12 o'clock saw sperm whales

Wednesday Aug. 9<sup>th</sup> Light air and pleasant, lowered for the whales, struck one and parted the line and lost the whale - Middle part the same - Latter part saw sperm whales and got 2



Thursday Aug. 10<sup>th</sup> Light breeze and pleasant, saw more whales, struck 2 and saved one, employed cutting Middle part commenced boiling. Latter part employed cutting and boiling. Lat. 21° 46' N. Long. 109° 34' W.
