

Friday Aug. 11th Light breeze and pleasant weather
boiling - Middle and Latter part the same
Lat. 21° 28' N.
Long. 109° 40' W.

Saturday Aug. 12th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading to the S. finished boiling and cleared
up the deck - Middle and Latter part the same
2 sails in sight - Lat. 22° 04' N. Long. 109° 56' W.

Sunday Aug. 13th Strong breeze and pleasant weather
heading to the S. one sail in sight, at Sunset
tacked Ship heading S. W. - Middle and Latter
part the same - Lat. 22° 08' N. Long. 110° 29' W.

Monday Aug. 14th Light breeze and fair heading to the
S. W. 2 sails in sight - Middle part heading
to the N. - Latter part much the same, employed
stowing Oil. Lat. 22° 22' N. Long. 110° 21' W.

Tuesday Aug. 15th Light air and calm, employed in the
hold, spoke the Bk. Catalpa of New Bedford
550 Sp. - Middle part heading to the S. and W.
Latter part heading N. Lat. 22° 37' N. Long. 110° 08' W.

Wednesday Aug. 16th Light breeze and pleasant, 2 sails
in sight - Middle part layd a bark - Latter
part heading to the S. and W. Lat. 21° 58' N.
Long. 110° 40' W.

Thursday Aug. 17th Strong wind and haze heading to
the S. and W., at 2 p. m. took in the light
sails and at 4 p. m. Ship heading to the N. E.
Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 22° 25' N.
Long. 109° 44' W.

Friday Aug. 18th Light breeze and pleasant steering S.
at Sunset took in sail and hauled a back, the
main top sail - Latter part it blew up
a Gale.

Saturday Aug. 19th Commenced with a moderate
Gale the Ship under a close reefed main
top sail, mizen and fore top most stay sails
the Ship heading from S. E. to N. E.
Middle part it blew a strong Gale, split
the mizen stay sail - Latter part it moderated
and made sail. Lat. 21° 54' N. Long. 109° 48' W.

Sunday Aug. 20th Commenced with a light wind
and a heavy swell the Ship under moderate
sail, the S. A. Parker in sight - Middle
and Latter part calm. Lat. 21° 48' N.
Long. 110° 02' W.

Monday Aug. 21st Commenced with a calm - Middle part
the same - Latter part light breeze heading N. E.
Lat. 21° 52' N.
Long. 109° 30' W.

Tuesday Aug. 22nd Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading N. E. at Sunset tacked Ship to the
S. and W. - Middle and Latter part calm
Lat. 21° 45' N. Long. 109° 24' W.

Wednesday Aug. 23rd Commenced with a calm
Middle part the same - Latter part light
breeze heading to the W. the water
employed in various ways
