Saturday Sept. 23rd Light breeze and hazy heading
S. E. by E. - Middle part the same - Latter part
at half past 10 p. m. tacked ship heading S. W. by W.
Lat. 1° 14' S. - Long. 84° 27' W.

Sunday Sept. 24th Light breeze and foggy heading S. W.
by W. - Middle and Latter part the same
Lat. 2° 04' S. - Long. 85° 39' W.

Monday Sept. 25th Light wind and hazy heading S. W. by W.
at Sunset tacked ship heading E. by S.
Middle and Latter part the same, saw Black
fish. Lat. 2° 43' S. - Long. 85° 01' W.

Tuesday Sept. 26th Light wind and hazy heading E. by S.
Middle and Latter part the same, employed setting
up shooks. Lat. 2° 42' S. - Long. 84° 58' W.

Wednesday Sept. 27th Strong breeze and hazy heading E. S. E.
employed setting up shooks - Middle part tacked ship
heading S. S. W. - Latter part tacked ship again
heading E. by S. and E. S. E., employed in the hold
and setting up shooks. Lat. 3° 12' S.
Long. 83° 36' W.

Thursday Sept. 28th Light breeze and hazy heading
E. by S. and E. S. E. employed in the hold
Middle and Latter part the same, saw Black fish
Lat. 2° 55' S. - Long. 82° 29'

Friday Sept. 29th Strong breeze and hazy heading E. S. E.
employed setting up shooks - Middle and Latter
part the same

Saturday Sept. 30th Commences with a very strong breeze
and rugged heading E. S. E., at Sunset took in all
the light sails and double reefed the fore top sail
Middle part strong wind and very rugged. Latter part
light breeze steering E. by S. with all sail out, at
10 a. m. saw the coast of South America

Sunday Oct. 1st Light breeze and hazy, steering down the
coast for Tombo - Middle part laid a back -
Latter part spread all sail and steered for Tombo

Monday Oct. 2nd Light breeze and hazy steering for Tombo
at 5 p. m. came to anchor - Latter part took in
a raft and got of some wood
