

Wednesday Oct. 25th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering N. W., at 3 p. m. saw a sperm whale, lowered 3 boats but without success the whale going to the windward quick. Middle part the wind very light the Ship heading to the S. E. - Latter part tacked Ship heading W. Lat 3° 12' N. Long. 83° 26' W.

Thursday Oct. 26th Light breeze and hazy heading W. S. W., at 3 p. m. spoke the Bark Paulina Cpt. Stanton 13 months out 500 bbls sp. Middle part heading to the E. Latter part were Ship heading to the S and W. Lat. 3° 02' N. Long 84° 03' W.

Friday Oct. 27th Commences with a light air and calm the Ship heading all around the compass the Paulina in sight, saw Blackfish and got one. Middle part light breeze heading to the Eastward Latter part the same, saw Blackfish. Lat. 3° 14' N. Long. 83° 53' W.

Saturday Oct. 28th Light breeze and hazy heading to the Eastward 2 Sails in sight, spoke the Paulina, saw Blackfish. Middle part the same - Latter part heading to the S. W. saw Blackfish and got 2. Lat 3° 08' N. Long. 84° 19' W.

Sunday Oct. 29th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S. W., employed clearing away the Black fish and boiled them out. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 4° 06' N. Long. 85° 02' W.

Monday Oct 30th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering N. W., one sail in sight, at Sunset took in the light sails and luffed to the wind heading S. W. by S. Middle part the same. Latter part calm. Lat. 3° 16' N. Long. 85° 58' W.

Tuesday Oct 31st Light air and hazy heading S. W. by W. Middle part were Ship heading E. S. E. Latter part the same. Lat. 3° 26' N. Long. 85° 43' W.

Wednesday November 1st Light breeze and hazy heading E. S. E., at Sunset took in the light sails and courses and hauled a back the main top sail - Middle part the same. Latter part made all sail, one sail in sight the Ship heading E. N. E. - Lat 2° 01' N. Long 83° 45' W.

Thursday Nov. 2nd Strong breeze and hazy heading E. N. E., at Sunset took in sail and wore Ship heading S. W. by S. Middle part the same Latter part made sail with a strong breeze. Lat 3° 26' N. Long. 85° 39' W.

Friday Nov. 3rd Strong breeze and hazy heading S. W. by W., spoke the Bark Paulina - Middle part hove a back with the main top sail - Latter part wore Ship and made sail heading E. one sail in sight. Lat. 3° 22' N. Long. 85° 51' W.

Saturday Nov 4th Light breeze and hazy heading E., one sail in sight, at Sunset took in sail for the night - Middle part the same Latter part wore Ship and made sail heading S. W. by W. one sail in sight
