

Friday Dec. 1st Strong breeze and pleasant heading
S. W. by S. spoke the Bk. Eugenia of
New Bedford Cpt. Wood, at Sunset
tacked Ship to the E. Middle part the
same - Latter part tacked Ship to the S. W.
Lat. 12° 52' S. - Long. 85° 54' W.

Saturday Dec. 2nd Strong breeze and hazy heading
to S. W., spoke the Barks Paulina and
Eugenia of New Bedford, at Sunset
tacked Ship to the N. E. - Middle and
Latter part the same, 2 Sails in sight
Lat. 12° 26' S. Long. 85° 18' W.

Sunday Dec. 3rd Strong breeze and hazy heading to
the N. E., 2 Sails in sight - Middle and
Latter part the same, 3 Sails in sight
Lat. 12° 23' S. Long. 84° 34' W.

Monday Dec. 4th Strong breeze and rugged with
squalls of rain, heading to the S. W., spoke
the Bark Paulina, at half past 5 p.m.
tacked to the N. E., and took in the light
sails. Middle part the same - Latter part
made sail, employed mending the mizen stay
sail, one sail in sight. Lat. 11° 57' S.
Long. 83° 37' W.

Tuesday Dec. 5th Light breeze and pleasant heading
to the N. E., at Sunset took in the
light sails - Middle and Latter part the
same

Wednesday Dec. 6th Light wind and hazy heading
to the E. spoke Ship Courier and
Harbinger - Middle and Latter part heading
to the S. W., 2 Sails in sight. Lat. 11° 49'

Thursday Dec. 7th Light breeze and hazy heading to
the S. W., spoke the Ship Harbinger of
Westport - Middle and Latter part the
same, saw one sail and some Blackfish
Lat. 12° 00' S.

Friday Dec. 8th Light breeze and pleasant heading
S. W., saw Blackfish and got 5, employed
clearing away the Blackfish - Middle part
tacked to the E. - Latter part saw the Bk.
Eugenia cutting in 4 y. whals she took the
day before, saw plenty of Blackfish. Lat. 11° 54' S.
Long. 83° 15' W.

Saturday Dec. 9th Light breeze and pleasant weather heading
to the E., one sail in sight and plenty of Blackfish
Middle part tacked to the S. W. - Latter part
the same, employed boiling Blackfish. Lat. 12° 01'
Long. 82° 55'

Sunday Dec. 10th Light breeze and pleasant weather
heading to the S. W. Middle part the same - Latter
part tacked Ship to the E., one sail in sight and
Blackfish. Lat. 12° 24' S. Long. 83° 25' W.

Monday Dec. 11th Light breeze and pleasant, heading to the
N. E., at half past 2 p.m. tacked Ship to the S. W.
Middle part the same - Latter part tacked to the
N. E. - Lat. 12° 51' S. - Long. 83° 45' W.
