

Saturday Dec. 23<sup>rd</sup>. Commences with a strong breeze and hazy heading to the S., one sail in sight, at Sunset took in sail and wore ship to the N. E. - Middle part wore round to the S. - Latter part at daylight wore ship again and made sail heading N. E. of S., 2 sails in sight. Lat. 12° 25' S. Long. 83° 15' W.

Sunday Dec. 24<sup>th</sup>. Light breeze and pleasant heading to the N. E., one sail in sight, at 4 p. m. wore ship to the S., at Sunset took in the light sails - Middle part the same - Latter part wore ship and made sail, steering N. E. 2 sails in sight. Lat. 12° 05' S.

Monday Dec. 25<sup>th</sup>. Light breeze and pleasant heading N. E., spoke the ship Harbinger of West. Port - Middle part heading E. N. E. - Latter part wore ship to the S., employed fitting the rigging, 2 sails in sight. Lat. 12° 08' S. Long. 82° 23' W.

Tuesday Dec. 26<sup>th</sup>. Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S., spoke the ship Courier of New Bedford. Middle part the same - Latter part tacked ship to the N. E., 2 sails in sight, employed on the rigging. Lat. 12° 22' S. Long. 82° 29' W.

Wednesday Dec. 27<sup>th</sup>. Light wind and pleasant heading to the N. E. with all sail out, employed on the rigging, 2 sails in sight, at Sunset took in the light sails and main sail - Middle part the same - Latter wore ship and made sail heading to the S., spoke the Courier and Harbinger, employed on the rigging. Lat. 12° 07' S.

Thursday Dec. 28<sup>th</sup>. Light breeze and pleasant heading to the N. E., employed on the rigging 4 sails in sight - Middle part the same - Latter part employed on the rigging, 3 sails in sight. Lat. 11° 38' S. Long. 80° 23' W.

Friday Dec. 29<sup>th</sup>. Light wind and pleasant, heading to the N. E., employed on the rigging, at Sunset tacked to the S. W. - Middle and Latter part the same, employed taring the rigging. Lat. 12° 10' S. Long. 80° 33' W.

Saturday Dec. 30<sup>th</sup>. Light air and pleasant heading to the S., finished taring down - Middle part the same - Latter part steering S. W. one sail in sight. Lat. 12° 51' S. Long. 80° 48' W.

Sunday Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>. Light breeze and pleasant, steering S. W., one sail in sight, saw Blackfish and got one, at Sunset took in sail and wore ship to the N. E. - Middle part wore ship to the S. - Latter part steered W. S. W. saw Blk fish. Lat. 13° 03' S. Long. 81° 58' W.
