

Friday Jan. 26th Commences with a Calm - Middle part the same - Latter part got a light breeze from the S. W. and steered E. S. E. Lat. 33° 25' N. Long. 92° 10' W.

Saturday Jan. 27th Light breeze from the S. W. and fine pleasant weather steering E. S. E. with all sail out - Middle part the same - Latter part the wind hauled to the S. E. the Ship heading N. E. by E. Lat. 33° 59' S. Long. 90° 05' W.

Sunday Jan. 28th Commences with a fresh breeze from the S. E. heading N. E. by E. with all sail out at Sunset took in the fore top gallant sail and stay sails - Middle part the same - Latter part took in the main top gallant sail, fly jib and gaff top sail. Lat. 33° 24' S. Long. 87° 55' W.

Monday Jan. 29th Strong wind and rugged heading E. N. E. one sail in sight - Middle and Latter part light winds heading S. S. W. with all sail out Lat. 33° 11' S. Long. 87° 16' W.

Tuesday Jan. 30th Light winds and hazy heading S. S. W. Middle part calm - Latter part a light breeze heading E. S. E., mended the fore top sail Lat. 33° 26' S. Long. 87° 16' W.

Wednesday Jan. 31st Light breeze and pleasant weather heading E. S. E. - Middle and Latter part steered S. E. $\frac{1}{2}$ E. Lat. 34° 05' S. Long. 86° 02' W.

Thursday Feb. 1st Commences with a fresh breeze steering S. E. by E. at 3 p. m. the wind hauled to the S. and E. the Ship heading E. - Middle and Latter part the same, saw Blackfish and got over. Lat. 34° 16' S. Long. 84° 18' W.

Friday Febr. 2nd Light breeze and pleasant heading E. N. E. employed clearing away the Blackfish - Middle part the same - Latter part were Ship heading S. by W. Lat. 34° 12' S. Long. 83° 39' W.

Saturday Febr. 3rd Strong breeze and pleasant heading S. by W., at 5 p. m. tacked Ship heading E. N. E. Middle and Latter part the same Lat. 34° 04' S. Long. 82° 16' W.

Sunday Febr. 4th Strong breeze and rugged heading E. N. E. at Sunset double reefed the fore top sail - Middle part the same - Latter part double reefed the main top sail. Lat. 33° 12' S. Long. 80° 43' W.

Monday Febr. 5th Strong breeze and very rugged under double reefed top sails, at Sunset wore Ship heading S. by W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W. Middle part the same - Latter part the wind very light and made all sail Lat. 33° 56' S. Long. 81° 17' W.

Tuesday Febr. 6th Commences with a light breeze heading S. saw a Fin back, at 5 p. m. wore Ship heading E. at Sunset saw a Sail to the windward - Middle and Latter part the same Lat. 33° 47' S. Long. 80° 45' W.

Wednesday Febr. 7th Light breeze and pleasant heading N. E. by E., at Sunset wore Ship heading S. Middle part calm. Latter part a light breeze from the N. E. the Ship heading S. E. Lat. 34° 22' S. Long. 80° 06' W.

Thursday Febr. 8th Light breeze from the N. and pleasant weather heading E. at 5 p. m. saw the Island Massafuero dist 50 miles bearing N. E. - Middle and Latter part heading N. E. by E. - Massafuero bearing N. dist 50 miles
