

Friday Febr. 9th Light breeze and pleasant the wind to the N. Massafuero bearing N. saw Blackfish and got 2, the Ship heading to the W. Middle part heading from N. E. by E. to N. N. E. - Latter part heading W. by S.

Saturday Febr. 10th Light breeze and hazy heading N. at 6 p.m. spoke the Bk. Vigilant of New Bedford - Middle part calm - Latter part stered for Massafuero, 3 sails in sight, at 9 a.m. 2 boats went on shore a fishing and got one Blackfish

Sunday Febr. 11th Light breeze and pleasant at 5 p.m. the boats returned with some fish made sail on the Ship heading to the E. - Middle part tacked Ship heading S. W. - Latter part made the same Lat. 33° 47' S. Long. 79° 55' W.

Monday Febr. 12th Light breeze and pleasant heading from S. E. to S. W., at sunset Massafuero bearing N. W. by N. dist. 12 miles - Middle part layd with the main top sail aback - Latter part made sail and stered N. W. 3 sails in sight. Lat. 33° 48' S.

Tuesday Febr. 13th Light breeze and hazy heading S. W. at 3 p.m. spoke the Ship George and Susan - Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 34° 15' S. Long. 81° 34' W.

Wednesday Febr. 14th Light breeze and hazy heading to the S. and W. Middle part calm - Latter part light breeze from the W. steering S. E. Lat. 34° 22' S. Long. 81° 19' W.

Thursday Febr. 15th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering S. E. Middle and Latter part the same one sail in sight Lat. 35° 25' S. Long. 80° 13' W.

Friday Febr. 16th Commences with a fresh breeze from the W. steering S. E. with all sail out - Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 36° 19' S. Long. 78° 37' W.

Saturday Febr. 17th Light breeze and hazy steering S. E. Middle part the wind hauled to the E. heading S. E. by S. - Latter part heading S. by S. E. saw Blackfish and got 3. Lat. 36° 31' S. Long. 78° 01' W.

Sunday Febr. 18th Light air and pleasant weather heading S. E. by E. cleared away the Blackfish and boiled them out - Middle part stered S. E. by N. - Latter part stered S. by N. Lat. 36° 54' S. Long. 76° 27' W.

Monday Febr. 19th Commences with a fresh breeze from the N. steering S. by N. E. - Middle and Latter part the same Lat. 36° 55' S. Long. 75° 46' W.

Tuesday Febr. 20th Light air and hazy heading N. E. by E. Middle part calm - Latter part saw the coast of Chile and stered for Talcahuano, one sail in sight

Wednesday Febr. 21st Commences with a fresh breeze and pleasant weather steering for Talcahuano, at 10 p.m. came to anchor in the bay - Latter part took the anchor and stood in to the anchorage

Friday Febr. 23rd Employed setting up shooks - Latter part brok out some oil and put it on board the Bark Winslow of New Bedford
