Thursday March 22nd Calm all hands on board but the Cpt.

Friday March 23rd First part the wind from the N. Latter part the wind from the S. at 10 a.m. the Cpt. came on board took the Anchor and stood out to sea

Saturday March 24th First part employed stowing the Anchors stowing N. W. found one man on board that had stowed him self away - Latter part stowing N. W.
