

Sunday March 25th Commences with a strong breeze from the S. steering N. W. by W. one sail in sight Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 31° 46' S. Long. 76° 14' W.

Monday March 26th Light breeze and pleasant steering N. W. by N. at 2 p. m. steered N. by W. wind from the S. Middle part the same. Latter part strong wind took in the studding sails. Lat. 29° 06' S. Long. 76° 40' W.

Tuesday March 27th Strong wind from the S. steering W. by N. employed in ship's duty, at 6 p. m. saw sperm whales blowing a moderate Gale, luffed to the wind and took in sail, the whales went down and we did not see them again, night coming on. Middle part kept the ship close to the wind. Latter part kept her N. W. Lat. 28° 08' S. Long. 78° 01' W.

Wednesday March 28th Strong wind from the S. steering N. W. by W. Middle part luffed to the wind. Latter part made sail steering N. W. by W. Lat. 26° 46' S. Long. 79° 36' W.

Thursday March 29th Strong wind from S. E. steering W. by S. at 4 p. m. saw the Island St. Felix at Sunset kept of N. W. by N. Lat. 24° 41' S. Long. 80° 39' W.

Friday March 30th Strong wind from S. E. steering N. W. by N. with all sail out. Ends the same. Lat. 22° 06' S. Long. 82° 23' W.

Saturday March 31st Strong wind from S. E. steering N. W. by N. employed settling up shooks. Ends the same. Lat. 19° 34' S. Long. 83° 21' W.

Sunday March April 1st Strong wind and squally steering N. W. by W. Ends the same. Lat. 16° 49' S. Long. 84° 55' W.

Monday Apr. 2nd Strong breeze and pleasant steering N. W. by N. with all sail out Middle and Latter part the same, employed shifting some of the water in the Ground tier. Lat. 14° 21' S. Long. 86° 13' W.

Tuesday Apr. 3rd Commences with a moderate breeze and pleasant weather steering N. W. by N. with all sail out, employed in the hold. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 12° 16' S. Long. 87° 24' W.

Wednesday Apr. 4th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering N. W. by N. employed in the hold. Latter part employed breaking out and coopering meat. Lat. 10° 12' S.

Thursday Apr. 5th Light breeze with light squalls of rain steering N. W. by N. with all sail out, employed in coopering and stowing back the meat. Latter part employed setting up shooks. Lat. 8° 20' S. Long. 89° 26' W.

Friday Apr. 6th Light breeze and pleasant weather, steering N. W. by N. employed setting up shooks. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 6° 26' S. Long. 90° 24' W.

Saturday Apr. 7th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering N. W. by N. at half past 2 p. m. kept her W. by N. 1/2 N. Middle and Latter part steered W. N. W. Lat. 5° 22' S. Long. 92° 45' W.

Sunday Apr. 8th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering W. by N. saw Blackfish. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 4° 30' S. Long. 95° 10' W.
