

Monday Apr. 23rd Commenced with a moderate baffling breeze from the E. steering N. W., send down the fore top sail and bent another one - Middle part the same - Latter part employed mending the fore top sail. Lat. 11° 30' N. Long. 115° 45' W.

Tuesday Apr. 24th Strong breeze and squally steering N. W. by N. employed mending the fore top sail Middle part the same - Latter part took in the light sails. Lat. 13° 20' N. Long. 117° 12' W.

Wednesday Apr. 25th Strong wind and rugged steering N. N. W., at 1 p. m. double reefed the top sails at half past 5 p. m. shock the reefs out the main top sails - Middle part the same - Latter part shock the reefs out the fore top sail. Lat. 15° 36' N. Long. 118° 20' W.

Thursday Apr. 26th Strong wind and rugged heading from N. W. by N. to N. W. by W. - Middle part the same - Latter part set the main top gallant sail fly jib and gaff top sail. Lat. 17° 29' N. Long. 120° 12' W.

Friday Apr. 27th Strong wind and rugged heading N. W. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 19° 15' N. Long. 122° 07' W.

Saturday Apr. 28th Strong breeze and rugged heading N. W. at half past 4 p. m. tacked Ship heading E. at Sunset tacked back again to the N. W. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 20° 14' N. Long. 123° 44' W.

Sunday Apr. 29th Light breeze and hazy heading from N. W. to N. W. by W. Middle and Latter part heading N. N. W. Lat. 21° 34' N. Long. 124° 40' W.

Monday Apr. 30th Light breeze and hazy heading from N. W. to N. by W. - Middle part strong breeze took in the stay sails - Latter part very squally with rain took in the main top gallant sail fly jib and gaff top sail. Lat. 23° 22' N. Long. 125° 36' W.

Tuesday May 1st Strong breeze and rugged heading to the N. and W. - Middle part more moderate - Latter part made all sail, at 10 p. m. tacked Ship heading E. by S. Lat. 24° 58' N. Long. 126° 32' W.

Wednesday May 2nd Light breeze and pleasant weather heading E. by S. - Middle and Latter part strong breeze heading from E. to E. by N. 1/2 N. no Obs.

Thursday May 3rd Strong breeze and rugged heading E. by N. took in the light sails - Middle part double reefed the fore top sail - Latter part the same. Lat. 26° 03' N. Long. 121° 44' W.

Friday May 4th Strong wind and very rugged heading E. by N. 1/2 N. - Middle part the same - Latter part more moderate made all sail. Lat. 23° 52' N. Long. 118° 33' W.

Saturday May 5th Light breeze and hazy with a heavy swell from the N. W. heading E. by N. 1/2 N. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 24° 05' N. Long. 115° 48' W.
