

Sunday May 6th Light breeze and hazy steering E. N. E.
Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 24° 13' N.
Long. 114° 07' W.

Monday May 7th Light breeze and pleasant weather steering
E. by N. 1/2 N., at sunset took in the light sails
and kept her E. Middle part the same. Latter
part made all sail and steered E. N. E. Lat. 24° 08'
Long. 112° 22' W.

Tuesday May 8th Light breeze and hazy steering E. N. E.
at 3 p. m. spoke the Richard Mitchell of
Nantucket 28 months out 400 bl's sp. at sunset
took in the light sails and tacked ship heading
W. S. W. Middle part the same - Latter part
steered N. E. saw the land. Lat. 24° 17' N.
Long. 111° 49' W.

Wednesday May 9th Strong breeze and rugged heading
S. at sunset took in sail and luffed to the
wind heading W. S. W. Middle part the same
Latter part made sail and steered N. E. one
sail in sight. Lat. 23° 30' N. Long. 111° 46' W.

Thursday May 10th Strong breeze and rugged steering
N. E. at half past 1 p. m. spoke the Bark
Sea Rose of New Bedford 300 sp. at 5
p. m. spoke the Ship Whesper of Fair
Haven, at sunset took in sail and wore
ship heading W. S. W., 3 sails in sight.
Middle part the same - Latter part wore
ship steering N. E. 4 sails in sight.
Lat. 23° 35' N.
Long. 110° 54' W.

Friday May 11th Light breeze and hazy steering S. E.
one sail in sight, at 3 p. m. luffed to the wind
heading S. W. and spoke the Bark Franklin
of New Bedford Cpt. Lee 22 months out
240 bl's sp. at sunset took in sail for the night
Latter part made sail and steered to the S. and E.
~~one sail in sight. Lat. 22° 55' N. Long. 110° 54' W.~~

Saturday May 12th Strong breeze and hazy steering to the
S. and E. one sail in sight, at sunset took in sail
for the night and luffed to the wind to the S. W.
Middle part the same - Latter part made sail
and steered to E. 3 sails in sight. Lat. 22° 57' N.
Long. 110° 16' W.

Sunday May 13th Light breeze and hazy heading to the
N. and E. spoke the Ship Sofia Somenos of
Trumbor, at sunset took in sail for the night heading
to the S. W. Middle part the same. Latter part
made sail and steered N. E. 3 sails in sight
Lat. 22° 17' N. Long. 110° 42' W.

Monday May 14th Light breeze and hazy steering N. E.
at sunset took in sail and wore ship heading to
the S. W. Cpt. H. Lucas bearing N. E. by E.
dist. 20 miles - Middle part the same - Latter
part made sail and steered N. one sail in sight
Lat. 22° 05' N. Long. 110° 29' W.

Tuesday May 15th Light wind and hazy heading
N. E. by W. spoke the Bark John A.
Parker of New Bedford. 70 bl's sp. on board
at sunset tacked ship and took in the light
sails heading N. N. E. Middle part the same
Latter part saw 2 sails. Lat. 22° 19' N.
Long. 110° 28' W.
