

Sunday June 24th Strong breeze and rugged steering
N. E. at Sunset saw Cape St. Lucas - Middle
and Latter part heading to the S. W.
Lat. 21° 47' N. Long. 110° 17' W.

Monday June 25th Light breeze and hazy heading to
the S. W. at the John A. Parker in sight
Middle part the same - Latter part employed shearing
oil. Lat. 22° 36' N. Long. 109° 40' W.

Tuesday June 26th Strong breeze and rugged heading N. W.
employed in the hold and washed ship - Ends
much the same. Lat. 22° 05' N. Long. 110° 03' W.

Wednesday June 27th Strong breeze and rugged heading S. W.
at Sunset tacked ship to the N. E. - Middle part
tacked to the S. W. - Latter part light breeze
heading to the N. E. Lat. 21° 52' N.
Long. 110° 19' W.

Thursday June 28th Light air and hazy heading to the N. E.
saw Black fish and 3 sails in sight - Middle
and Latter part the same. Lat. 22° 10' N. Long. 109° 57' W.

Friday June 29th Light breeze and pleasant heading
to the N. at Sunset took in sail and tacked
to the S. W. 2 sails in sight. Middle part the
same - Latter part made sail heading in shore
Lat. 22° 38' N. Long. 109° 58' W.

Saturday June 30th Light breeze and hazy heading to
the S. W. spoke the Ship Garland of New Bedford
Middle part the same - Latter part heading to the N.
Lat. 21° 54' N. Long. 110° 15' W.

Sunday July 1st Light breeze and pleasant heading various
courses - Ends the same. Lat. 22° 00' N. Long. 109° 45' W.

Monday July 2nd Light breeze and pleasant heading various
courses, spoke the John A. Parker - Middle part
calm. Latter part heading to the N.
Lat. 22° 37' N. Long. 109° 47' W.

Tuesday July 3rd Strong breeze and pleasant heading to
the N. at Sunset tacked ship and took in
sail - Middle part the same - Latter part made
sail, 4 sails in sight. Lat. 21° 53' N. Long. 110° 37' W.

Wednesday July 4th Light breeze and pleasant heading S. W.
one sail in sight, at 4 p.m. tacked ship to the N.
Ends the same. Lat. 22° 09' N. Long. 110° 41' W.

Thursday July 5th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the
N. spoke the John A. Parker - Middle part lay
a back - Latter part heading to the N. E. 2 sails
in sight. Lat. 22

Friday July 6th Light air and calm 2 sails in sight
at Sunset wore ship to the S. W. - Ends much
the same

Saturday July 7th Light breeze and pleasant heading various
courses, saw blk fish and spoke the Barkes Person
and John A. Parker - Latter part heading to the
N. W. lowered for Blackfish but got none

Sunday July 8th Light breeze and pleasant steering N. W.
Middle part the same - Latter part saw blk fish
and got 3. Lat. 22° 28' N. Long. 111° 26' W.
