

Monday July 9th Light breeze and pleasant steering N.W. by N. employed clearing away the blk. fish, at Sunset took in the light sails - Middle part the same Latter part made sail, 2 sails in sight
Lat. 22° 46' N. Long. 111° 57' W.

Tuesday July 10th ~~Light breeze and hazy steering~~ various courses, spoke the Ship William Betch. Middle part heading to the S.W. Latter part employed boiling blk. fish, 2 sails in sight. Lat. 22° 45' N. Long. 111° 57' W.

Wednesday July 11th Light breeze from the S.E. and hazy steering N. N.W. at Sunset took in sail and steered N.W. by N. Ends steering N.W. with all sail out, spoke the Barks Mercator and Hydasphe
Lat. 23° 58' N. Long. 112° 00' W.

Thursday July 12th Light breeze and pleasant steering N.W. the land in sight and 2 sails - Middle part steered W. N.W. - Latter part steered N.W. 2 sails in sight
Lat. 24° 37' N. Long. 112° 25' W.

Friday July 13th Light breeze and hazy steering W. N. W. Middle and Latter part very foggy and calm

Saturday July 14th Light breeze and foggy heading to the W. spoke the Barks Hydasphe and Marie Frances Middle part heading to the N. - Latter part tacked Ship to the S.W. 3 sails in sight. Lat. 25° 18' N. Long. 112° 50' W.

Sunday July 15th Light breeze and foggy heading to the S.W. 3 sails in sight, at Sunset tacked to the N.W. Ends heading to the S.W.
Lat. 24° 48' N. Long. 113° 22' W.

Monday July 16th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S.W. caught a turtle, 4 sails in sight, at 5 p.m. tacked Ship to the N. - Middle part tacked Ship to the S.W. - Latter part the same, 4 sails in sight
Lat. 24° 13' N. Long. 114° 15' W.

Tuesday July 17th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S.W. employed making a jill, at 2 p.m. tacked to the N. at Sunset 7 sails in sight Middle part the same - Latter part tacked to the S.W. 8 sails in sight. Lat. 24° 32' N. Long. 114° 23' W.

Wednesday July 18th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S.W. 4 sails in sight, at 4 p.m. spoke the Bark Hydasphe - Middle and Latter part steered S.W.

Thursday July 19th Light breeze and thick cloudy weather steering S. S.W. picked up a log one sail in sight Ends the same. Lat. 21° 50' N. Long. 116° 44' W.

Friday July 20th Light breeze from the N. with light squalls of rain steering S. - Ends the same
Lat. 20° 39' N. Long. 116° 45' W.

Saturday July 21st Light breeze from the N. steering S. by E. with pleasant weather Ends the same
Lat. 19° 26' N. - Long. 116° 46' W.

Sunday July 22nd Light breeze and pleasant weather steering S. S.E. - Latter part steered S.E. by S.
Lat. 17° 01' N. Long. 116° 23' W.

Monday July 23rd Strong breeze and rugged steering S.E. Middle part squally took in the light sails Latter part the same heading S.W. Lat. 14° 55' N. Long. 115° 59' W.
