

Tuesday Aug 7th Strong breeze and dark cloudy weather heading E. S. E. - Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 4° 00' N. Long. 99° 30' W.

Wednesday Aug 8th Strong breeze and pleasant weather heading from E to E. S. E. - Middle and Latter part heading E. by N. Lat. 4° 18' N. Long. 97° 18' W.

Thursday Aug 9th Strong breeze and pleasant heading E. by N., employed mending the Gaff top sail Middle and Latter part heading E. S. E., employed mending the fore sail. Lat. 4° 14' N.

Friday Aug 10th Strong breeze and dark cloudy weather heading E. S. E., bent the fore sail - Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 3° 33' N. Long. 94° 08' W.

Saturday Aug 11th Strong breeze and squally with rain heading E. S. E. - Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 3° 07' N. Long. 92° 34' W.

Sunday Aug 12th Strong breeze and hazy heading E. S. E. saw a fin back - Middle and Latter part the same. Lat. 2° 24' N. Long. 91° 04' W.

Monday Aug 13th Strong breeze and rugged heading E. S. E. Ends much the same. Lat 2° 14' N. Long. 89° 17' W.

Tuesday Aug 14th Strong wind and rugged heading E. by S. Ends the same. Lat 1° 43' N. Long. 87° 18' W.

Wednesday Aug 15th Light breeze and hazy heading from E to S. E. Ends the same, one sail in sight Lat. 00° 59' N. Long 85° 11' W.

Thursday Aug 16th Strong breeze and hazy heading from E to S. E., one sail in sight, saw Blackfish and got one - Middle part the same - Latter part 3 sails in sight one of them was boiling

Friday Aug 17th Light breeze and hazy spoke the Shk Superior of New Bedford and Champion of Westport - Middle part heading to the S. W. Latter part saw 2 sails, the Cpt of the Champion came on board of us, employed fixing the fore top gallant back stays. Lat 00° 04' N.

Saturday Aug 18th Light breeze and hazy heading to the S. and W. the Champion in sight, employed setting up the fore top gallant rigging and backstays, at 5 p. m. tacked ship to the S. and E. - Middle and Latter part the same

Sunday Aug 19th Light breeze and foggy heading the S. E. 2 sails in sight - Middle part the same - Latter part spoke the Bark Leonidas of New Bedford

Monday Aug 20th Light breeze and foggy heading to the S. E. the Leonidas in sight - Middle and Latter part the same. Lat 1° 02' S. Long 83° 05' W.

Tuesday Aug 21th Light breeze and pleasant steering N. one sail in sight, at sunset took in the light sails and hauled a back the main top sail heading to the S. E. Ends steering N. N. E. - Lat 00° 16' S.

Wednesday Aug 22th Light breeze and pleasant steering N. E. 2 sails in sight, spoke the bark Wyandoe of New Bedford, Middle and Latter part much the same. Lat. 00° 00' Lat 82° 33' W.
