Saturday Aug. 25th Light breeze and hazy heading to the
E one sail in sight - Middle part tacked to the
W - Latter part 4 sails in sight saw a bark
to the windward chasing whales Lat. 00° 35' N
Long. 83° 18' W.

Sunday Aug. 26th Light breeze and fair weather 2 sails
in sight working the ship to the windward
Middle part the. Latter part heading to the
S. and E., 4 sails in sight. Lat. 00° 11' N
Long. 83° 14' W.

Monday Aug. 27th Strong breeze and hazy heading to the
E spoke the Ship William Roth and Bark
President - Middle part the same - Latter part
steered E. by N. and E. N. E., Lat. 00° 12' N
Long. 81° 55' W.

Tuesday Aug. 28th Strong breeze and rugged steering
E. 1/2 N. saw black fish and got one - Latter
part saw the Coast of South America

Wednesday Aug. 29th Anchored in Comarades
and came out again on the Latter part of Satur-
day Sept. 1st saw the Bark Cachalot

Sunday Sept. 2nd Strong breeze and pleasant working
the ship up to the windward the land in
sight - Middle part the same - Latter part headed
in for the land

Monday Sept. 3rd Strong breeze and hazy, at 2 p.m.
anchored at ~~San Juan~~ ~~San Juan~~ Latter part employed
sending down the main topmast cross trees to fix
them one boat on shore getting wood

Tuesday Sept. 4th Employed fitting rigging, one
boat wooding

Wednesday Sept. 5th Employed setting up rigging and
getting of wood

Thursday Sept. 6th Got of our wood and let the
Bark Hydaspes have 10 bbls of meat, at 4 p.m.
took our Anchor and headed of shore Ends much
the same. Lat. 1° 10' N Long. 80° 58' W.

Friday Sept. 7th Strong breeze and rugged the ship
heading to the W. employed in various ways
Ends the same

Saturday Sept. 8th Light breeze and hazy heading to the
W. at 3 p.m. tacked to the S. E. at Sunset took
in the light sails - Middle part tacked ship to
the W. - Latter part made sail and tacked ship
to the S. E. Lat. 1° 33' N Long. 81° 20' W.

Sunday Sept. 9th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the
S. E. - Middle part the same - Latter part tacked
to the W. one sail in sight. Lat. 00° 41' N.
