

Monday Oct. 15th Went on shore to cut wood and get some water

Tuesday Oct. 16th Employed cutting wood and getting water

Wednesday Oct. 17th Employed getting wood and water and layd here till the latter part of the 25th when we got under way and stood out to sea and lost 68 fathoms of cable

Friday Oct. 26th Strong breeze and pleasant working the ship up to windward in company with the John A. Parker and the Hydaspes - Middle and latter part the same. Lat. 1° 14' N. Long. 79° 38' W.

Saturday Oct. 27th Strong breeze and pleasant the ship heading to the S. E., 2 sails in sight, at 5 p.m. tacked to the W. - Ends much the same. 5 sails in sight

Sunday Oct. 28th Strong breeze and rugged heading to the S. E., 2 sails in sight, at Sunset tacked to the W. - Middle part the same - Latter part headed to the S. E. one sail in sight Lat. 00° 29' N. Long. 80° 57' W.

Monday Oct. 29th Strong breeze and hazy heading to the S. E., at sunset tacked to the W. 3 sails in sight - Middle part the same - Latter part heading to the S. E. one sail in sight - Lat. 00° 17' N. Long. 80° 48' W.

Tuesday Oct. 30th Light breeze and fine pleasant weather heading to the S. E., one sail in sight, saw black fish and went 2, at Sunset tacked to the W. Middle part the same - Latter part tacked to the S. E., saw 2 sails, employed hauling black fish Lat. 00° 25' N. Long. 80° 52' W.

Wednesday Oct. 31st Light breeze and hazy heading to the S. E., at night tacked to the W. - Ends the same 2 sails in sight. Lat. 00° 15' N. Long. 81° 20' W.

Thursday Nov. 1st Strong breeze and rainy heading to the S. E. 2 sails in sight - Middle part headed to the W. Latter part headed to the S. E. one sail in sight Lat. 00° 02' S. Long. 81° 06' W.

Friday Nov. 2nd Strong breeze and hazy heading to the S. E., saw 3 sails - Middle part headed to the W. Latter part headed to the S. E., employed mending the fly jib. Lat. 00° 08' S. Long. 81° 13' W.

Saturday Nov. 3rd Strong breeze and pleasant heading to the S. E., at sunset took in the stay sails and tacked to the W. Middle part the same Latter part headed to the S. E. one sail in sight. Lat. 00° 11' S. Long. 81° 09' W.

Sunday Nov. 4th Strong breeze and pleasant heading to the S. E. 3 sails in sight, at dark tacked off shore Middle part the same - Latter part the same, 6 sails in sight Lat. 00° 42' S. Long. 81° 05' W.
