

Thursday Jan. 10th Commences with a fresh breeze and hazy heading to the S. W., at 3 p. m. saw Sperm whales and struck 3 but lost one, saved 2. Middle part layd by the whales Latter part employed cutting Lat. 2° 02' S. Long. 93° 28' W.

Friday Jan. 11th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S. W. employed clearing away the heads and commenced boiling at sunset wore Ship to the E. Middle part wore Ship to the S. W. Latter part the same employed boiling Lat. 2° 33' S. Long. 94° 03' W.

Saturday Jan. 12th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the E. employed boiling Middle part the same Latter part finished boiling and wore Ship to the S. W. with all sail out Lat. 2° 40' S. Long. 93° 56' W.

Sunday Jan. 13th Light breeze and hazy heading to the S. W. with all sail out Ends the same Lat. 4° 10' S. Long. 95° 00' W.

Monday Jan. 14th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S. W. with all sail out Middle part the same Latter part employed coopers oil Lat. 5° 50' S. Long. 96° 18' W.

Tuesday Jan. 15th Commences with a fresh breeze and pleasant weather, heading to the S. W. with all sail out, employed coopers oil Middle part the same Latter part employed stowing down oil Lat. 7° 40' S. Long. 97° 33' W.

Wednesday Jan. 16th Strong breeze and rugged heading to the S. W. employed stowing oil, took in the top gallant sails and fly jib Middle part made all sail again Latter part light breeze, bent another jib No Obs

Thursday Jan. 17th Light air and pleasant heading to the S. W. employed bending a new main top sail, a new mizzen stay sail and a fore top mast stay sail Middle and Latter part strong breeze employ in Ship duty Lat. 10° 47' S. Long. 99° 00' W.

Friday Jan. 18th Commences with a strong breeze from the E. and pleasant weather, the Ship heading S. E., employed in various ways Ends much the same Lat. 12° 35' S. Long. 99° 20' W.

Saturday Jan. 19th Commences with a fresh breeze and a rugged sea the Ship heading to the S. with all sail out Middle part the same Latter part employed breaking out flour and molasses Lat. 14° 36' S. Long. 99° 34' W.

Sunday Jan. 20th Commences with a strong breeze and very rugged heading S. by E with all prudent sail out Ends much the same Lat. 15° 36' S. Long. 100° 11' W.

Monday Jan. 21st Strong breeze and a heavy head beat sea and clear weather, the Ship heading S. with all prudent sail out Middle part the same Latter part squally with rain employed mending the main top gallant stay sail Lat. 18° 24' S. Long. 100° 34' W.

Tuesday Jan. 22nd Strong breeze and rugged heading to the S. Middle part the same Ends with a light breeze Lat. 20° 20' S. Long. 100° 44' W.

Wednesday Jan. 23^d Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S. Middle part the same Latter part headed S. E. employed on the rigging Lat. 22° 25' S. Long. 100° 32' W.

Thursday Jan. 24th Light breeze and pleasant heading S. E., employed on the rigging Ends with variable winds, heading from S. W. to S. E. Lat. 23° 46' S. Long. 100° 54' W.
