

Friday Jan. 25th Light breeze and pleasant weather heading to the S., employed in various ways. Ends the same. Lat. 25° 38' N. Long. 100° 53' W.

Saturday Jan. 26th Light breeze and pleasant weather heading to the S. and E. with all sail out, employed in Ship duty. Middle part the same. Latter part employed breaking out the meat. Lat. 21° 27' S. Long. 100° 47' W.

Sunday Jan. 27th Light breeze and fine pleasant weather heading to the S., employed in the hold. Ends the same. Lat. 29° 15' S. Long. 100° 47' W.

Monday Jan. 28th Light breeze and squally heading to the S. Middle part the same. Latter part employed on the rigging. Lat. 30° 42' S. Long. 100° 45' W.

Tuesday Jan. 29th Light breeze and pleasant weather heading to the S., employed on the rigging. Ends the same. Lat. 31° 39' S. Long. 101° 16' W.

Wednesday Jan. 30th Light breeze and pleasant weather the Ship heading from S. by E. to S. S. W., employed on the rigging. Middle part the same. Latter part a strong breeze. Lat. 33° 14' S. Long. 101° 57' W.

Thursday Jan. 31st Light breeze and pleasant weather heading to the S. employed in various ways. Middle part the same. Latter part heading E. by S., employed mending the main sail. Lat. 34° 37' S. Long. 100° 46' W.

Friday Feb. 1st Commences with a fresh breeze from the N. and fine pleasant weather, steering E. with all sail out, employed mending the main sail. Middle part the same. Latter part the wind N. N. W., set the fore top mast and main top gallant studding sails, steering E., employed in various ways. Lat. by Ob. 35° 29' S. Long. by Chron. 98° 05' W.

Saturday Feb. 2nd Commences with a fresh breeze from the N. N. W. and hazy steering E. by N. with all sail set. Middle part the same. Latter part the wind N. W. Lat. 36° 10' S. Long. 95° 09' W.

Sunday Feb. 3rd Commences with a fresh breeze from the N. W. and hazy steering E. by N. with all drawing sail out, employed in various ways, saw white water and luffed to for it, but saw no more of it, kept the Ship her course again. Middle part the same. Latter part the wind hauled to the S. E. with thick rainy weather, took in the studding sails, the Ship heading to the N. and E. by the wind. Lat. 35° 55' S. Long. 92° 25' W.

Monday Feb. 4th Light breeze from the S. E. with thick rainy weather the Ship heading to the N. and E. with all sail out, at sunset took in the stay sails and fore top gallant sail. Middle part a very light breeze from the N. E., the Ship heading E. S. E. Latter part much the same, made all sail. Lat. 35° 47' S. Long. 91° 46' W.

Tuesday Feb. 5th Commences with a Calm, employed in various ways. Middle part got a light air from the N. W., steering E. by N. Latter part the same. Lat. 35° 48' S. Long. 91° 21' W.

Wednesday Feb. 6th Light breeze and pleasant weather, steering E. by N. with all sail out. Ends the same. Lat. 35° 55' S. Long. 89° 45' W.

Thursday Feb. 7th Moderate breeze from the N. W. and pleasant weather steering E. by N. with all sail out. Middle part the wind hauled to the S. and rainy, took in the light sails and main sail. Latter part more moderate, made some sail. Lat. 35° 43' S. Long. 88° 45' W.

Friday Feb. 8th Strong breeze from the S. E. and hazy, heading E. N. E. at 3 p. m. saw sperm whales, lowered the boats but got none, at sunset came on board and wore Ship to the S. W. Middle part the wind hauled to the N., the Ship heading E. N. E. Latter part made all sail, saw a Ship steering S., at 10 a. m. the wind increased so that we double reefed the top sails and furled the main sail. Lat. 35° 37' S. Long. 85° 03' W.
