

Wednesday Febr. 20th Commences with a light breeze and pleasant weather the Ship working up the bay, at 5 p.m. came to anchor at Talcahuano a number of vessels in port - Latterpart employed sending down the fore top gallant mast

Thursday Febr. 21st Employed in various ways - Latterpart employed sending down the fore top mast and getting off 30 fathoms of cable

Friday Febr. 22nd Employed in ship duty - Latterpart employed painting ship

Saturday Febr. 23rd Employed painting ship - Latterpart employed breaking out oil and coopersing it

Sunday Febr. 24th Fine pleasant weather, all hands on shore

Monday Febr. 25th Employed painting ship and in various other ways

Tuesday Febr. 26th Employed in various ways, fitting the fore top mast rigging and so forth

Wednesday Febr. 27th Commences with thick foggy weather with the wind from the N., employed in various ways - Ends with fine pleasant weather, wind from the S.

Thursday Febr. 28th Commences with pleasant weather, wind from the S. employed in various ways - Latterpart hauled along side the Ship Emerald and discharged some oil on board of her and employed breaking out and coopersing oil

Friday Febr. 29th Employed breaking out and coopersing oil and discharging it, all hands on board - Ends the same

Saturday March 1st Employed breaking out and coopersing oil and discharging it, all hands on board - Ends the same, discharged our cruise men

Sunday March 2nd First part finished discharging the oil and cleared up the deck

Monday March 3rd Latterpart hauled away from the Emerald and let go the Anchor, employed sending up the fore top mast - So Ends

Tuesday March 4th Employed setting up the Backstays and the fore top masts head- and Backstays - Latterpart sent on shore 200 Gallons of blackfish oil and employed in various other ways

Wednesday March 5th Employed sending up the fore- and fore top sail yards - Latterpart employed stowing the hold.

Thursday March 6th Employed clearing up the deck and got some lumber from the Ship Kentucky - Latterpart got 12 pipes from the Ship Hunter and took some water on board

Friday March 7th Employed stowing the hold and got 6 bbls of Beef and 2 pipes of bread from the Bk Eliza both - Latterpart employed stowing the hold

Saturday March 8th Employed clearing up the deck and getting ready to paint, got the rest of our water on board - Latterpart employed washing ship

Sunday March 9th Employed painting the stamens and commenced painting the spars - Latterpart let the barboard watch go on liberty

Monday March 10th Commences with pleasant weather, one watch on liberty - Latterpart blowing a hole from the N. with thick rainy weather

Tuesday March 11th Commences with a Gale from the N. and thick rainy weather - Ends much the same

Wednesday March 12th Commences with thick rainy weather, wind from the N. - Latterpart clear weather employed painting
