Wednesday Apr. 16th Light breeze and pleasant steering N.E., employed ~~in various ways, at sunset took in the top sails and wore~~ ship to the W. - Middle part the same - Latter part steering to the N., no ends. Lat. 21° 00' S. Long. 71° 15' W.

Thursday Apr. 17th Strong breeze from the S., steering to the N., employed in various ways, the Land in sight, at sunset took in sail for the night and kept her W. - Middle part the same - Latter part steered N.E. - No Obs.

Friday Apr. 18th Light wind and hazy steering to the N. employed in ship duty, at sunset took in sail for the night and kept her N.W. - Middle part the same - Latter part steering N., cathead a turtle - Lat. 19° 28' S. Long. 71° 30' W.

Saturday Apr. 19th Light breeze and hazy, steering N., the watch employed in ship duty - Middle part steered W. by S. - Latter part the same - Lat. 19° 09' S. Long. 73° 07' W.

Sunday Apr. 20th Light breeze and pleasant, steering W. by S., spoke the Bk. Morning Star of New Bedford - Middle part headed by the wind to the S.W. - Latter part calan, one sail in sight - Lat. 19° 11' S.

Monday Apr. 21st Light air and pleasant, steering N.W. one sail in sight - Middle part steered W.N.W. Latter part steered N.W. employed making a main sail out of a old main top sail, one sail in sight - Lat. 18° 31' S. Long. 75° 13' W.

Tuesday Apr. 22nd Strong breeze and dark cloudy weather, steering W.N.W., employed making a main sail, spoke the Bk. Morning Star - Ends much the same, employed on the main sail - Lat. 17° 27' S. Long. 75° 55' W.

Wednesday Apr. 23rd Strong breeze and pleasant weather, steering W.N.W., employed on the main sail, saw blackfish - Middle part steering N.W. - Latter part steered N. - Lat. 16° 47' S. Long. 78° 14' W.

Thursday Apr. 24th Strong breeze and rigged steering N., employed on the main sail - Ends steering N.W., saw a sail - Lat. 14° 41' S. Long. 78° 26' W.

Friday Apr. 25th Strong breeze and pleasant, steering N.W., employed on the main sail - Middle part steered W. by N. - Latter part the same - saw a sail and bent the main sail. Lat. 13° 34' S. Long. 80° 03' W.

Saturday Apr. 26th Light breeze and pleasant weather, steering W. by N. employed in various ways about the ship - Middle and Latter part the same - Lat. 13° 00' S. Long. 82° 03' W.

Sunday Apr. 27th Fresh breeze and pleasant weather, steering N. by W. Middle and Latter part the same - No Obs.

Monday Apr. 28th Strong breeze and dark cloudy weather, steering N. by W. at sunset kept her N.W. - Middle part the same - Latter part steered N. by W., employed mending the old main top gallant sail - Lat. 9° 06' S. Long. 82° 42' W.

Tuesday Apr. 29th Strong breeze and pleasant weather, steering N. by W. - Middle part light breeze - Latter part the same, employed mending the outer jib, saw blackfish and got one - Lat. 7° 40' S. Long. 82° 59' W.

Wednesday Apr. 30th Light breeze and pleasant, steering N., employed mending the outer jib, saw blackfish and got one and cleaned him away - Ends much the same - Lat. 6° 09' S. Long. 82° 41' W.
