

Thursday May 1st Commences with light airs and calm, heading to the N. and E. employed in mending the gaff top sail - Latter part employed boiling Blackfish and caught 3 more Lat. $5^{\circ} 47' S.$ Long. $82^{\circ} 24' W.$

Friday May 2nd Light air and hazy heading to the N. and E., employed boiling Blackfish - Latter part employed in the hold, saw a great many Blackfish Lat. $5^{\circ} 41' S.$ Long. $82^{\circ} 15' W.$

Saturday May 3rd First part light breeze and pleasant, heading E., employed in the hold, saw Blackfish - Latter part saw the Coast of Peru Lat. $5^{\circ} 04' S.$ Long. $81^{\circ} 16' W.$

Sunday May 4th Light breeze and pleasant weather, storing in for Paita 3 sails in sight, at 5 p.m. hauled off shore and took in some of the light sails - Latter part stored in for Paita with all sail out, at half past 8 a.m. the Capt. and his wife went on shore in one of the boats, the Ship Clifford Whaine of Fair Haven and the Bk Franklin of New Bedford standing off and on

Monday May 5th Commences with fine pleasant weather, the Ship standing off and on off Paita, at half past 12 o'clock the boat returned, having the Capt and his wife on shore, with orders for the Ship to stand out to sea and return again on Tuesday, made all sail and stood out to sea at sunset took in the light sails and main sail Middle part at 2 a.m. tacked in shore - Latter part made all sail, saw Blackfish, lowered for them but got none, the Ship heading in shore, so Ends Lat. $5^{\circ} 04' S.$ Long. $80^{\circ} 56' W.$

Tuesday May 6th Commences with fine pleasant weather, the Ship heading in shore, at 4 p.m. wore Ship off shore and took in the light sails and main sail - Middle part at 12 o'clock wore Ship in shore - Latter part made all sail heading in for Paita

Wednesday May 7th Hauled a back off Paita and sent a boat on shore for the Capt. at 1 p.m. the Capt. and his wife came on board and a man that he has shipped here, made all sail and stored W. S. W. - Middle part stored W. - Latter part stored N. W., employed cooping Beef, so Ends Lat. $4^{\circ} 18' S.$

Thursday May 8th Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.E. and fine pleasant weather, storing N.W., employed in cooping beef and storing it down - Ends much the same Lat. $3^{\circ} 27' S.$ Long. $83^{\circ} 22' W.$

Friday May 9th Light breeze and hazy storing W. S. W., employed in ship duty saw Blackfish, lowered one boat but got none - Latter part saw Blackfish and got 7 110 lbs

Saturday May 10th Light breeze and hazy, took the Blackfish along side and shared them away, storing W. S. W. - Latter part much the same employed boiling Blackfish Lat. $3^{\circ} 44' S.$ Long. $85^{\circ} 54' W.$

Sunday May 11th Light breeze and pleasant storing W. S. W., finished boiling, at 2 p.m. kept her of N. by W., at sunset hauled a back the main top sail heading to the N. and E. - Latter part stored N. W. Lat. $2^{\circ} 56' S.$ Long. $86^{\circ} 04' W.$

Monday May 12th Light breeze and hazy storing N. and sunset luffed to the wind heading N.E. and hauled a back the main top sail Middle part the same - Latter part stored N. W., saw Blackfish and got 5
