

Thursday June 12th Strong breeze and rugged, employed cutting - Middle part clearing up the deck - Latter part took in the whales head

Friday June 13th Strong breeze and rugged heading to the S.E., employed clearing away the case and commenced boiling, Ends with pleasant weather, employed boiling

Saturday June 14th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the S.E., employed boiling - Middle part the same - Latter part strong breeze and rugged Lat. 3° 09' N. Long. 87° 46' W.

Sunday June 15th Strong breeze and rugged heading to the S. and E. employed boiling, at sunset wore ship to the W. - Middle part finished boiling - Latter part set the main sail Lat. 2° 51' N. Long. 88° 43' W.

Monday June 16th Strong breeze and rugged heading to the S. and W. - Latter part coopers oil and breaking out

Tuesday June 17th Strong breeze and squally with rain heading to the S.W., employed in the hold and coopers oil - Latter part heading to the E., employed stowing down oil - Lat. 1° 54' N.

Wednesday June 18th Strong breeze and rugged, heading to the E., employed stowing down oil - Middle part headed to the W. with the main top sail a back - Latter part headed to the W. under easy sail employed stowing oil. Lat. 1° 41' N. Long. 91° 41' W.

Thursday June 19th Light breeze and pleasant, heading to the W., saw Cullpepper and Wommans Islands, finished stowing the hold and washed ship 4 sails in sight, at sunset wore ship to the S.E. - Latter part headed to the W., Cullpepper and a number of sails in sight, employed in various ways

Friday June 20th Light breeze and dark cloudy weather heading to the S.W., Cullpepper and a number of sails in sight, at sunset wore ship to the E. - Ends the same - Lat. 2° 05' N. Long. 92° 05' W.

Saturday June 21st Light breeze and hazy heading to the E. saw Cullpepper and one sail - Latter part heading to the S.W. Lat. 1° 51' N. Long. 92° 08' W.

Sunday June 22nd Light breeze and pleasant heading to the N.E., Cullpepper and 3 sails in sight - Middle part layd a back - Latter part stored N. N. E. Lat. 2° 10' N. Long. 92° 11' W.

Monday June 23rd Light breeze and pleasant steering N. N. E., at sunset hauled a back the main top sail - Latter part made sail heading to the E. Lat. 2° 26' N. Long. 92° 00' W.

Tuesday June 24th Light breeze and pleasant heading to the E. - Latter part headed to the S.W., saw a sail - no Obs

Wednesday June 25th Strong breeze and rugged heading to the S.W., at dark wore ship to the E. - Latter part stored N. E. Lat. 2° 34' N. Long. 91° 41' W.

Thursday June 26th Strong breeze and rugged steering E. N. E., at sunset took in sail and luffed to the wind heading to the E. - Ends much the same - Lat. 3° 03' N. Long. 90° 31' W.

Friday June 27th Strong breeze and rugged heading to the E., at sunset took to the S.W. - Ends much the same - Lat. 2° 51' N. Long. 91° 03' W.

Saturday June 28th Strong breeze and rugged heading to the S.W. with moderate sail out, employed mending the main top mast stay sail - Latter part light breeze, made all sail and bent a new main top gallant sail, one sail in sight Lat. 2° 25' N. Long. 92° 06' W.
