Friday Apr. 10th First part light breeze from the N. W. steering E. by N. latter part light southerly wind - Lat. 36° 31' S. Long. 88° 38' W.

Saturday Apr. 11th First part light air from the S. W. steering E. by N. latter part wind N. N. W. Lat. 36° 34' S. Long. 87° 30' W.

Sunday Apr. 12th First part light N. S. W. breeze, steering E. by N., latter part strong breeze, one sail in sight Lat. 36° 53' S. Long. 85° 06' W.

Monday Apr. 13th Fresh Gales and fair weather, steering E. by N. 1/2 S. Lat. 36° 44' S. Long. 81° 29' W.

Tuesday Apr. 14th Fresh Gales from the N. W. and hazy weather steering E. by N. 1/2 S. Lat. 37° 19' S. Long. 78° 29' W.

Wednesday Apr. 15th Fresh Gales from the N. and rainy, heading E. N. E. Lat. 37° 11' S. Long. 76° 51' W.

Sunday Apr. 19th First part fresh breeze from the W. and clear, steering N. E., latter part light breeze, 2 sails in sight, at 10 a.m. saw the land Lat. 36° 42' S.

Monday Apr. 20th Commences with a light air from the W. and hazy steering E. N. E., 3 sails and the land in sight, at Sunset ~~headed to the W. steering E. by N. 1/2 S. bearing~~ E. by N. dist 13 miles - Middle part standing off and on very squally with rain - latter part clear weather with a light breeze from the S., steering in for Talcahuano, so ends, 2 sails in sight

Tuesday Apr. 21st Commences with a light breeze and clear weather the Ship working up the bay, at 7 p.m. came to off Talcahuano, a number of vessels in port, latter part employed washing Ship and getting ready to get water
