Sunday May 10<sup>th</sup> Strong breeze from N. N. W. and rainy steering  
S. by E. Lat. 41° 54' S. Long. 80° 51' W.

Monday May 11<sup>th</sup> Fresh Gales from N. W. and rainy, steering S. by E.  
Lat. 44° 30' S. Long. 81° 31' W.

Tuesday May 12<sup>th</sup> Blowing a Strong Gale from N. W., steering S. by E.  
Layd to from 4 p. m. to 2 a. m. Lat. 45° 48' S. Long. 80° 59' W.

foreward davit Lat. 57° 25' S.
