at 7 A.M. sent down the Main topsail to repair Employed repairing
sail nothing in sight Lat By Ob 36 57 Long By Chron 18 41 By Dist 18 57 East

Remarks on Board Sunday 15th Sept
First part Brisk breeze from North steering E.S.E.
at finished the Main topsail and sent it aloft one sail
in sight Middle part Brisk breeze from North steering E.S.E.
Latter part Strong breeze from N.W. steering E.S.E. two sail in
sight saw a finback Lat By Ob 37 08 Long 22 14 East

First Strong breeze from N.W. steering E.S.E. one sail in sight
