First part light winds from East and haze with thunder
at 4 the wind haul'd S.E. wore ship heading E.S.E. on
sail in sight Middle fine weather at 6 M. Latter part
thick foggy weather from S.E. heading to the Eastward
one sail in sight Lat 35 41 Long 11 30

Remarks on Board Sunday 16th Feb
First part light winds from S.E. heading E by N
at 9 P.M. spoke the Bark Indus of Port Glasgow, Eng-
dis not understood where bound thicker foggy weather
Middle fine present weather at 4 Capt off N.E. at 6 Pastor
head bore 1st compass N.W. by N light by the wind heading
N.W. Latter part Strong Breeze from N.W. at 11 got in to
the Sound took in top-sail and dols for an
Mizen top-sails Blowing very fresh from West

Remarks on Board Monday 17th Feb
First part Strong Breeze and flaver from N beating
up the Sound at 1 took in 1st at 3 took in main-sail
and dols. Mizen top-sails and took a Pilot at 6 came
to Anchor of the Harbours in 7 fathoms of water and fast to
the Sails Laying at Anchor ship Kufell & Barks Hope
of N Bedford Latter part Brisk Breeze from S.W. Laying
at Anchor in the Sound waiting for a wind to get in to
the harbour

Remarks on Board Tuesday 18th Feb
This day fine Breeze from S.W. at 2 A.M. the
wind haul'd S.E. at 4 got under way and stood in to the
harbour got on to the Bars and the winds haul'd of
head came to anchor at 6 and fast to the Sails at 10 took
over anchor and towed the Ship in to the harbour
and came to Anchor in 4 fathoms of water

Remarks on Board Wednesday 19th Feb
First part light winds from S.W. at 3 S.M. craft
of casks a shoar for water Latter Strong Breeze
from East one Boat crew a Shore filling water and
on watch one liberty

Remarks on Board Thursday 20th Feb
First part Strong Breeze from E on Boat
crew a Shore for water & on watch on liberty
Latter the same on watch a shore one liberty Mizen
Engin in ship duty

Remarks on Board Friday 21st Feb 1840
First part Strong Breeze from East Engin in ship duty one
watch a shore one liberty Middle light winds from S.W. and fine
weather Latter part Strong Breeze from S.W. got off the raft of water
and hoisted it in on watch a shore one liberty

Remarks on Board Saturday 22nd Feb 1840
All this day brish breeze from Western Engin Stowing down
water & on watch a shore one liberty

Remarks on Board Sunday 23rd Feb 1840
First part Brish Breeze from West. Sent a raft of casks a
shore on watch a shore one liberty Middle & Latter light winds
from S.E. one watch a shore one liberty & one Boat crew a filling
water

All this day Strong Breeze from East Engin watering and
painting ships & on watch a shore one liberty fore
Mizen Absconded Richard Smiths Charles Dore James
Kee and James Bradley

All this day fine Breeze and fine weather Engin painting
Ship Stowing water & on watch a shore one liberty

Remarks on Board Wednesday 26th Feb
All this fine Breeze and fine weather Engin in ship

This day Engin in ship duty one watch fishing
