 got under way and proceeded to sea Stowed the anchors unbent
 the cables and stowed them below

Remarks on Board Friday 13th March 1840
 First part Strong Breeze from N.E. heading S.E. at 1 took
 top gallant sails at 2 PM the fore topsail
 parted and split the sail had sent it down and sent up a
 new one at dark took in sail Middle fresh gale
 from N.E. Latter the same employed painting Boats fitting
 Boats & 4 Latter 3 1/2 00

Remarks on Board Saturday 14th March 1840
 First part fresh gale from N.E. heading South Emp. in
 painting Boats fitting Boats & 4 Nothing in sight
 Middle the same Latter fresh gale from N.E. at
 day light set the fore topsail double reefed
 and wore ship heading S. Nothing in sight
 Latter 3 1/2 00

 topsail and Sols of the runaways Sudd at dusk at 4 took
 in the fore sail Latter fresh gale from N.E. at day
 light set double reefed at 10 took in at 11 1/2 00

 in the fore sail Middle the same Latter fresh gale at 4
 set double reefed topsail unbent the Main sail and reefed it up for
 patches Nothing in sight Latter 3 1/2 00 South

Remarks on Board Tuesday 10th March 1840
 First part light winds from S. heading N.E. at 11 AM
 ripping up sails Middle the same Latter part light winds and thick
 weather at day light made sail Employed painting cabin & 4
 saw a hump back Latter 3 1/2 00

Remarks on Board Wednesday 11th March 1840
 First part Brisk Breeze N.E. unbent the old Main topsail
 and sent a new one & a new Mainsail Emp. painting cabin
 & 4 Nothing in sight at dark took in sail and bare ship
 heading S. at 11 Middle the same Latter variable winds and
 at day made sail and sent down the fore sail to repair at 7
 took in fore & Mizzen topsails Squally weather at 8 set
 the fore topsail double reefed Nothing in sight

Remarks on Board Thursday 12th March 1840
 First part Brisk breeze from South steering West Emp.
 Mending fore sail at 1 finished and sent it at dark
 took in fore topsail Middle Light winds from N.E. at 9
 wore ship heading S. Latter part Strong breeze from
 S. at 11 heading S. at day light made sail at 10 took
 in fore and Main sail Emp. Mending Main topsail
 Nothing in sight Latter 3 1/2 00 Long 11 4 00 East

Remarks on Board Friday 13th March 1840
 First part Strong Breeze from S. heading S. at 11
 Emp. Mending sail at dark took in sail and wore
 ship Nothing in sight Middle the same Latter part light winds
 and cloudy weather heading S. Emp. in Ship's duty & 4

 First part Light winds from S. and cloudy weather Emp.
 setting up fore rigging & at dark took in sail heading
 N.E. Latter part Light winds from South steering West
 Employed setting up fore rigging & 4 Nothing in sight
