This day light winds from S.E. with a heavy swell
Setting in to the Bay at 10 A.M. Landed & chased 2 whales
No success 2 P.M. Landed and struck the Iron Break
Emp. setting up Shocks

Remarks on Board Tuesday 23rd June
All this day light winds and variable Emp. setting
up Shocks Saw 1 right whale & one humpback
Out Side

Remarks on Board Wednesday 24th
All this day brisk breeze from N.W. saw 1 whale
Out Side. Employed setting up Shocks and painting
Boat &c &c

Remarks on Board Thursday 25th
All this day brisk breeze from N.W. at 11 struck
and killed a whale at 11 miles from the Martha
Cove & calf.

Remarks on Board Friday 26th
This Day variable wind and weather. No whale in the
Bay

Remarks on Board Saturday 27th
All this day light wind and variable weather
at 11 P.M. struck and drew from a small whale at
chase. No success saw a humpback &c &c

Remarks on Board Sunday 28th June
All this day light winds from S.E. and fine weather
No whale in sight this day

Remarks on Board Monday 29th
All this day light winds from E.S.E. No whale
in sight

Remarks on Board Tuesday 30th June
All this day brisk breeze from E.S.E. and fine
weather saw 4 whales out Side

Remarks on Board Wednesday 1st July
All this day strong breeze from N.E. and weather
saw 2 or 3 whales out Side

Remarks on Board Thursday 2nd July 1840
All this day strong breeze from N.E. and fine weather
at 10 P.M. Landed for a whale. No success saw 1 whale out
Side

Remarks on Board Friday 3rd July 1840
All this day light winds from North and fine weather
saw 1 or 2 whales out of the Bay

Remarks on Board Saturday 4th July 1840
All this day fine breeze from N.W. at 10 P.M. struck and killed
a whale about 10 miles from the Martha Cove. Took him to
the Amazon at 5 P.M. commenced cutting at 7 finished a cow
and calf at 10 P.M. commenced boiling

Remarks on Board Sunday 5th July 1840
All this day light winds and fine weather at 3 P.M. Landed for
a whale. No success Employed Boiling

Remarks on Board Monday 6th July 1840
All this day light air and calm at 11 finished boiling
Latter part Employed breaking out between Shocks
No whale in sight

Remarks on Board Tuesday 7th July
All this day fine breeze from N.W. and fine weather
Employed stowing down Cibo &c No whale in sight

Remarks on Board Wednesday 8th July 1840
All this day strong breeze from N.E. and fine weather Emp.
setting up Shocks &c &c saw 2 whales out Side

Remarks on Board Thursday 9th July
All this day strong breeze from N.W. and rain squalls
at 2 P.M. Landed for a humpback. No success Employed
setting up at Shocks &c &c

Remarks on Board Friday 10th July
All this day strong breeze from N.W. and squalls
saw 1 or 2 whales Employed setting up Shocks &c &c
