Remarks on Board Thursday 30th July
All this day fine breeze from South and fine weather
at 8 A.M. Lowered for a whale struck and killed at 9 took
hurd to the Martha's Vineyard and chased to dusk
at 12 Lowered for two, whale struck and then run out
to sea and was first to cut berry rigged out side
saw 5 or 6 whale

Remarks on Board Friday 31st July
All this day light winds from S and fine weather
at 9 struck and killed a small right whale at 10
commenced towing at 12 took her to the ship at 10
struck a large cow & calf at 11 commenced towing at 3
took her to the ship at 4 commenced cutting
at dark finished saw 5 or 4 whale

Remarks on Board Saturday 1st Aug 1840
All this day strong breeze from North and smoky weather at
day light commenced towing at 10 finished at 10 p.m. Lowered
for a humpback at 11 struck and killed at 12 commenced
towing at 4 took her to the Martha at 4 p.m. commenced
Boiling several humpbacks in sight

Remarks on Board Sunday 2nd Aug 1840
this day variable wind and weather Employed Boiling
No. 4. No whale in sight one boat of fishing

Remarks on Board Monday 3rd Aug
All this fine breeze from S.E. and fine weather Employed
Boiling 4 men a shore with the Scurry one boat a
fishing saw one whale a gowing quick to the westward
at dark finished Boiling

Remarks on Board Tuesday 4th
All this day strong strong gale North Employed
Stowing down Oil at 3 P.M. Lowered for a humpback
and chased to success at dark the wind hauled
N.W. and blew hard

Remarks on Board Wednesday 5th
All this day strong gale from N.W. and fine weather
at 5 P.M. Lowered for a humpback to success Employed
Boiling

Remarks on Board Thursday 5th Aug
All this day heavy gale and bad weather from S.W. No whale
in sight

Remarks on Board Friday 7th Aug
All this day light winds from S.E. and fine weather
No whale in sight

Remarks on Board Saturday 8th Aug
All this day light winds from S and fine weather at 10
chased a humpback to 11 P.M. Lowered for a whale
struck and killed and got her to the shore bar at 4 p.m.
took her to the Martha saw 2 humpbacks

Remarks on Board Sunday 9th Aug
All this day fine breeze from S and fine weather
Employed repairing Boat No. 4 saw one humpback

Remarks on Board Monday 10th Aug 1840
All this day brisk breeze from S.W. and variable weather
Employed repairing Boat at 8 Lowered for a whale and
saw nothing more of here

Remarks on Board Tuesday 11th Aug
All this day strong breeze from North and fine weather
No whale in sight Employed repairing Boat

Remarks on Board Wednesday 12th
All this day strong gale from S.W. and squally
weather No whale in sight

Remarks on Board Thursday 13th
All this day strong gale from S.W. and rainy squally
weather nothing in sight

Remarks on Board Friday 14th
All this day fresh gale from S.W. to N.W. and bad
weather No whale in sight

All this day brisk breeze from S.W. and fine weather
