All this day fine breeze from S.E. at 12 struck and
killed a bright whale at 5 took the whale to
ships

Remarks on Board Tuesday 18th August
All this day light wind and fine weather at day light
commenced cutting at 8 Lower and struck & killed a
humpback. At the time the humpback turned
up, up came a bright whale struck and killed
here at 8 took the humpback to the Amazon
and the bright whale to Martha saw an other
humpback and we gave chase no success came
a board and finished cutting the bright whale

Remarks on Board Wednesday 19th Aug
All this day fresh gale from W. & S.W. weather
at day light commenced cutting the humpback at
9 & finished and commenced boiling no whale in
sight

Remarks on Board Thursday 20th
All this day brisk breeze and fine weather
Lower and chased whale twice no success saw no
whale

Remarks on Board Friday 21st Aug
All this day light wind and variable with fine
fine weather commenced cutting at 1 P.M. Lower
for a bright whale at 4 took her
to the Amazon saw one humpback

Remarks on Board Saturday 22nd Aug
All this day fine breeze and fine weather at day
light commenced cutting at 9 P.M. finished
stowing down no whale in sight

Remarks on Board Sunday 23rd Aug
All this day light wind and fine weather at
day light commenced boiling saw 2 whale out side

Remarks on Board Monday 24th Aug 1840
All this day variable wind and weather at 12 finished boiling
Employed stowing down at 4 P.M. it came on to rain and
thunders & lightning

Remarks on Board Tuesday 25th August 1840
All this day fine breeze and fine weather Employed stowing
down oil no whale in sight

Remarks on Board Wednesday 26th August
All this day fine breeze and fine weather Employed clearing
Hawse up to at 10 P.M. saw a calf struck and
killed at 3 P.M. commenced towing at 4 saw an other
and gave chase struck and killed at 5 P.M. took one whale
to Martha at 6 P.M. took the other to the Amazon saw 1 more whale

Remarks on Board Thursday 27th August 1840
All this day fine breeze from S.E. and variable weather
at 8 A.M. commenced cutting at 11 finished and commenced
boiling saw one whale

Remarks on Board Friday 28th Aug
All this day fine breeze from S.E. and fine
weather at 11 A.M. saw a whale struck &
killed at 12 took her to Martha Employed
boiling no more whale in sight

Remarks on Board Saturday 29th Aug
All this day light wind and rainy weather Employed
stowing down oil saw one whale

Remarks on Board Sunday 30th Aug
All this day light wind from East and rainy
bad weather no whale in sight Employed stowing
down oil

Remarks on Board Monday 31st Aug
All this day strong gale from S.E. and thick
rainy weather with a heavy dew from S.E.
