

Remarks on Board Wednesday 23rd Sept
Middle Strong Breeze and thick haze weather Steering
East. E. at 3 o'clock Tied to with the Main top sail
aback Latter part Strong Breeze from N.W. at 6 o'clock
of N.E. with thick squally weather at 8 it lighted
up and the E. Ende of Hangeroo Island was perceived
It Dist 25 Miles Lat 36 15 Long 138 14 E by chron

Remarks on Board Thursday 24th Sept
First part Light wind from S.E. heading up the passage
with a head tide at dark was abreast of Antiochamber
Bay Middle Light air and calm heading up in to the gulf
Latter part fine Breeze from N.E. and fine weather
at 10 came first anchor in Kingscote Harbour in 3 1/2 fathoms
water and fixed the sails &c

Remarks on Board Friday 25th Sept 1840
First part light air and calm the capt went ashore
and got some vegetables for the crew &c Middle & Latter
the same got a part of the sick ashore to a Boarding
House &c Bot one Sheep

Remarks on Board Saturday 26th Sept.
This fine weather and calm one watch ashore on
Liberty and all the sick Latter part got the
remainder of the sick ashore and carried them
some provisions to the ship Lalla Brooks of
London 100 fathoms long line was there about and Bot
4 Jugs of fine Juice

Remarks on Board Sunday 27th Sept
This day commenced with fine Breeze from South
and fine weather but some dark times Middle &
Latter the same one watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Monday 28th Sept
First part fine Breeze from E and fine weather
one watch ashore on Liberty Dark times Middle
and Latter the same went and looked up the
watering place &c Bot of one Sheep and a
small Pig one watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Tuesday 29th Sept 1840
First part fresh gale from S.W. one watch ashore
on Liberty Middle the same one watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Wednesday 30th Sept
First part Strong Breeze from S.W. and squally weather one watch
ashore on Liberty Middle and Latter part fine Breeze
from S.W. and fine weather Employed breaking out casks
and rafting them for water one watch ashore on
Liberty Bot of a fine Cow from shore

Remarks on Board Thursday 1st Oct 1840
First part fine Breeze and variable got a raft
of casks ashore &c one watch ashore on Liberty
Bot of one Sheep of the Schooner True Love of
London and placed him in pasture ground for fowls
and let him have 40 or 50 fathoms of tow line
Middle and Latter the same Employed filling water and
breaking out between decks &c one watch ashore
on Liberty

Remarks on Board Friday 2nd Oct 1840
This day fine Breeze and fine weather Employed filling
water & breaking out between decks the capt & 3 Mate off
on a fishing excursion with a gang from shore took 100
fathoms tow line & a seine of twine &c and went off shore for
the night Latter part Employed filling water and breaking
out between decks and coopered the bread from 11 casks
of New Bread and 3 of Old and 10 lbs of Flour George
& Cabern a Shore Drunk when it was his
Duty one Board Ship got 6 bottles of Pickles and 2 small
cheeses from the Schooner True Love one watch ashore on
Liberty and the sick getting smart
