

Remarks on Board Wednesday 14th Oct 1840
First part of this light air and calm with fine weather latter part fresh gale with thunder & lightning at 12 o'clock P.M. struck a drift let go the Starboard Anchor and Brought the Ship up Employed in Ship's duty and painting Boat coiling Line &c &c one watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Thursday 15th Oct
All this day variable winds and weather with thunder and lightning at day light hove up the Starboard Anchor and Brought Calm Employed in Ship's duty &c one watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Friday 16th Oct 1840
First part of this day strong gale and rainy weather latter part heavier gale from west with heavy squalls of rain one watch ashore on Liberty at dark all came off but George I Caber Thomas Melville and George Farbox

Remarks on Board Saturday 17th Oct
All this day strong gale from S.W. one watch ashore on Liberty at dark all came off and Melville Farbox and Mrs Caber and all others but Mrs Caber and was as drunk as a Drunkard

Remarks on Board Sunday 18th Oct
All this day fine breeze from N.E. and fine weather one watch ashore on Liberty the remainder of the sick came off from Shore G.I.C. ashore they came as usual

Remarks on Board Monday 19th Oct
All this day fine breeze and fine weather Employed making Lane warp and painting Boat &c at dark all hands came off G.I.C. came off the same as usual

Remarks on Board Tuesday 20th Oct 1840
All this day fine breeze and fine weather Employed making ropes fitting rigging &c &c G.I.C. Boat with the harrers and watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Wednesday 21st Oct
All this day strong breeze from S.E. and fine weather Employed making ropes & hanging fitting rigging &c one watch ashore on one shore G. Farbox and G.I.C. Boat with the harrers

Remarks on Board Thursday 22nd Oct 1840
All this day fine breeze and variable at 10 A.M. a small Sloop arrived from Adelaide with potatoes and sheep &c for the Julian I tun of potatoes and 8 sheep for us Capt. Hays came back in the Sloop and left Capt. Smith at Adelaide took the sheep & potatoes aboard and sent 4 boxes of tobacco a load of the Sloop Employed in Ship's duty &c one watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Friday 23rd Oct 1840
All this day light wind and fine weather Employed in Ship's duty &c at 1 P.M. the Sloop got under way for Adelaide Mrs Holmes & Mrs Cole the 2 Mate of the Julian went up to Adelaide for Capt. Smith in the Sloop one watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Saturday 24th Oct 1840
All this day light wind and fine weather Employed in Ship's duty &c one watch ashore on Liberty Ashes & Abandon

Remarks on Board Sunday 25th Oct
All this day fine breeze and fine weather one watch ashore on Liberty

Remarks on Board Monday 26th Oct 1840
All this day Breeze Breeze and variable weather one watch ashore on Liberty Employed in Ship's duty &c &c
