Remarks on Board Monday 9th Nov 1840
 First part light wind from S. N. saw one or 2 finbacks
 and one sail in sight steering to the N E at dark took
 in sail latter part light air and calm at day
 light made sail Employed in ship's duty &c

Remarks on Board Tuesday 10th
 First part light and calm Employed in ship's
 duty &c at dark took in sail saw two of finbacks
 latter part fresh gale from S. E. at day light made
 sail & took in sail it came on thick rainy weather
 Lat 37 06 Long 36 28

Remarks on Board Wednesday 11th Nov
 First part heavy gale from south middle moderate
 gale latter part light wind and fine weather from south
 at day light made sail Employed making gun gear
 ropes saw 2 or 3 fin backs Lat 36 12 South

Remarks on Board Thursday 12th Nov 1840
 First part light air and calm heading N. E. N. Employed in ship's
 duty &c at 4 o'clock one boat for a fin back was success
 middle the same latter part brisk breeze from N. E. at
 day light made sail steering S. N. Employed repairing
 mizen topsail Lat 36 40 Long 131 06

Remarks on Board Friday 13th Nov 1840
 First part strong breeze from N. E. steering S. N.
 saw 1 finback at dark took in sail middle and latter
 the same at day light set double reefed topsails
 & main sail nothing in sight heading N.
 at 12 took in the main sail
 Lat 37 21

Remarks on Board Saturday 14th Nov 1840
 First part strong breeze from N. E. heading N. nothing in sight
 at dark took in sail latter part light wind from south at
 day light made sail heading west Employed in ship's duty &c
 nothing in sight Lat 37 08 Long 129 09

Remarks on Board Sunday 15th Nov 1840
 First part light air and calm from south nothing in
 sight Employed in ship's duty and making rig &c
 latter part brisk breeze from N at day light made sail heading
 N. E. N. nothing in sight Lat 37 05 Long 128 46

Remarks on Board Monday 16th Nov 1840
 First part strong breeze from N heading N. E. at
 dark took in sail latter part strong breeze from N at day
 light made sail heading N. E. N. nothing in sight
 Lat 36 57 Long 127 45

Remarks on Board Tuesday 17th Nov 1840
 First part strong breeze from N. E. heading N
 at dark took in sail latter part fresh gale from S. E. N.
 at 8 A.M. set the fore topsail double reefed and kept of it
 nothing in sight Lat 35 39 Long 126 04 East

Remarks on Board Wednesday 18th Nov 1840
 First part fresh gale from S. E. steering N at dark
 took in sail heading west nothing in sight
 latter part light wind from S. E. at day light made sail heading
 S. N. nothing in sight Lat 35 15 the

Remarks on Board Thursday 19th Nov 1840
 First part fine breeze from S. E. steering S. N. saw
 one finback at dark took in sail latter part light
 wind from S. E. at day light made sail Employed
 setting up rigging &c Lat 35 57 Long 126 51

Remarks on Board Friday 20th Nov
 First part light wind from S. E. at 2 P.M. saw
 2 finbacks & 2 whales at dark took in sail latter
 part strong breeze from N. E. N. at 10 took in sail
 blowing hard Lat 36 44 Long 126 25
