 First part brisk breeze from S.E. steering
 N by E at dark took in sail 2 sail in sight
 Latter part strong breeze from S.E. and fine
 weather at day light Made sail steering
 N. by W. nothing in sight
 Lat 35 07 Long 115 20

Remarks on Board Tuesday 10th
 First part strong breeze from South
 steering N. by W. nothing in sight
 at dark took in sail left to heading
 S W Latter part light air and calm
 from N at day light Made sail and steered
 N.E. found the leak and stoped it in part
 Lat 35 01 Long 114 55

Remarks on Board Wednesday 11th
 First part light wind from W steering
 East at 4 the wind shifted S. by W. and blowed
 heavy with thick rainy weather put the
 ship under a close reefed main top sail &c
 saw a shoal of killer and one sail
 Middle & Latter strong gale from S.W. &
 nothing in sight
 Lat 35 00 Long 114 50

 First part strong gale from S.W.
 Latter part brisk breeze from South
 at day light Made sail 2 sail in sight
 Lat 34 37 Long 114 10

Remarks on Board Friday 13th Jan 1844
 First part brisk breeze from S. at 2 P.M. the ship
 of Larbariers and gale 57 fathoms of the ship at dark
 took in sail
 Latter part fine breeze from S heading East
 at day light Made sail one sail in sight
 Employed fitting rigging &c &c
 Lat 34 25 Long 114 07 East

Remarks on Board Saturday 14th
 First part brisk breeze from S by W heading
 E. by S at 4 Made Cape Green bearing East
 25 miles at 5 more ship ship heading N. by W.
 at dark took in sail Latter part brisk
 breeze from S.W. heading S.E. 2 sail in sight
 but no whale Employed fitting rigging &c &c
 Lat 34 22 Long 114 49

Remarks on Board Sunday 15th
 First part strong breeze from S. by W.
 heading S.E. one sail in sight at dark
 took in sail Latter part fine breeze from
 S. by W heading W at day light Made sail nothing
 Lat 34 35 Long 112 40

Remarks on Board Monday 16th Jan 1844
 First part fine breeze from S. by W heading
 S. by W. nothing in sight at dark took in sail
 Latter part light wind from S. by E at day light
 Made sail nothing in sight Employed repairing
 Spanker fitting rigging &c &c Lat 34 27

Remarks on Board Tuesday 17th
 First part brisk breeze from S. by E Employed
 fitting rigging &c nothing in sight
 Latter part brisk breeze from S.W. at day light
 Made sail heading S. by E Employed fitting rigging
 Sent the fore top gallant Mast aloft &c &c
 Lat 35 03

 First part strong breeze from S.W. sent the
 Main top gallant Mast aloft &c &c at dark took in sail
 Latter part strong breeze from S.W. at day light Made sail &c &c
 Lat 35 27 Long 112 10
