

packages and started a peddling the cloth
seems very dull for 1848 people as for the houses
they are set up from the ground about three
feet high and are made of the same material as the
houses there is a few soldiers in this place see them take
a man in to the Fort but the greatest of all was
to see us going down some a foot others on Bunkers
or Coles with a boy behind with a Bunkers
but the worst of it was some of them had a Pat-
ch on their eye and they could not walk quite
as straight as usual all of the week went off their
Liberty was out - excepting one which came
on Saturday seen some then on the Beach
a partying for us paired off did nothing this
day on the following the other men took their
Liberty doing sundry jobs on board Breking
out for Betty Breege and sheet - and occasionally
putting the Pilot to take out a ship as he
with us for some time the ships are going
out and others coming in all Banned for that
furned place Japan expecting to fall through
I am afraid some of them will be dissapoi-
nted carried the Capt ashore and stayed for the
week got them of every man at eight though
they were rather Roisterous one of them was
sick washed and sent the Boat ashore at
day light for three carried shoes and cut it in
two carried one Cord with two Boats took of them

Chased this day & stored it in the house. Week started
the next day after more line of us took a march in
to the Bush after some gold saw plenty of same
here cut a high lead they started for the Boats
there was a Kamackap buried this day ashore that
belonged to a ship had a rain or frequent showers
the Liverpool came in here the one that sailed about
the time that we did this day is Sunday washed of
one Boats crew sent ashore this I went on board
the Swift she has a thousand lbs of wool had frequent
showers throughout the day the Capt of some of the
ships are going off high one went out without paying
the Governor a further laid off and on till night - fall
they went in and tried to steal some of provisions they
fought hard for their Liberty more came and rescued
them hearing their cries the Boats crew nearly killed
a Spaniard but they made a narrow escape of being
caught - this day being Sunday nothing was done
one Boats crew went to the tower and then coming
all hands at day light stored down what wood there
was on board they put potatoes over board they being
short several of them washed and sent the Boat
after long none had come down so they came back
saw a sail expect it is coming in here though I can
