Saturday Jan 27 1849
At 10 AM Capt. took his Tobacco on deck and told
us to take what we wanted now for he was a
going to put it up very light and quick squared
in about a day after this night plenty of
sight Fish going but they would not
bite washed of passed up a sharp light breeze
now that which is just to be seen from
the boat here

Sunday Jan 28 1849
Steering at 10 AM nothing in sight some reading
at 11 AM sleeping and some of the time
very strong they're fresh fore and main top sails
sails the decks quite wet for the thick water had
further main top sail sail steering full and by
some of the time will head her over the
not wash of this morning nothing in sight
cleaned out our South Boat put on a new
Boat to it setting up the lee fore and main
rigging still strong wind

Monday Jan 29 1849
Set up the fore main rigging the Capt took
a dinner then came and to tend the course to
11 AM squared in the quick cloud up deck
strong breeze through the night shows water
occasionally making it rather uncomfortable in water
