got up Old Junk to make gun of dressing
gave very light breeze steering ESE

Wednesday Feb 15
Had a shift of wind heading by E killed another
Keg strong breeze took in light sail a little rain
doubled reefed top sail. To go around quite
dark this night - a head of shock reef out of one
and main top sail heading ESE the deck em-
ployed in making gun of gun boring sail
coasting lines &c

Thursday Feb 16
Work on sail and gun jam killed two Kegs
this day they sailed like the sea here where
there is so many mountains to fill one ship
heading ESE the waves in company we
get thumped ship find that she is a tight-
keel a Box clear up deck set chain top sail
have a light in the rigging so that we may know
where each other are. begin to find a little difference
in the weather especially in the morning left-
sided of made all sail to work knitting
gave fitting main top sail. Boer Tenant
putting on things where they are poor and sorry
other jobs

Friday Feb 16
Set out for her to Jan Capt came on board here

After going there find them very busy to work
see Transpore and Brookes at a distance
on board at a signal from the Capt very well
squad in steering & course of P.P.P.
the waves on our quarter about half a mile
as for ships I have not seen a Whaler that
I would rather belong to than this this one
suits me in every way as well as any Whaler
could as for firing it is good and better than
half the ships that I have seen so far as to
work there is no such up job as they call it - our
no unnecessary work then to up main sail right down
it catches a large wave and shakes them to
work on the other main top sail Boer Tenant
the Capt. went on board the seven Brookes
for better hand kept them by not enough in
the waves carrying the sail low and left

Saturday Feb 17 In the Blue Sea Feb 18
The Brookes and I went on for them but
they proved to be Pump Back at killed one
Keg this day saw several Fin Back nothing
else to be seen yet we are now in the Blue Sea -
clear up deck. As come on board fetched a keg
of some sort of Legum thicket in Line guide
the Capt. has stored some of them from ship-
ping on deck setting them with a Bucket of
