steering at day weather strong breeze three
Water some keep a light in the rigging washed
a back up for water in a 1000 took in 10 minutes
but see no life washed up main sail set at 11
see her heading off West gained a back of breeze

Friday Feb 19
Fair but rain sail dirty weather doubled reefed
top sail set chain Spencer heading off the West
some of a sea on did not see spent this day
rain or thick fog all the time we are nearly out
of fresh do not expect to get any more for a
long time washed of main reef out chain the
going the Whidbey sound took the Coler out fast
left ship so that the Boatswain should not
be in shock the Capt out for a 1000 in the
sail had the old main top sail on deck
mending steering fall and by

Thursday Feb 20 Lat 31.30 Long 128.50 E

Blue sea, wind
Made all sail see plenty of Fair Backs
the Warren the Capt got more Blacksmithing
done to fix the Windlass expected to see Land on
our lee beam but it was thick there is something
in this sea it looks quite different from what
we have been seeing for the time past Head-
ing off W a pleasant night rather chilly to
us for we have just come out of warmer waters
washed of to work on. Spent some time in
a boat tried to catch some fish
but they would not bite found 250th of water
the Capt went on board the Warren to get some
bottle first heading off some to work in rigging

Wednesday Feb 21
Thick fog at times see another ship ahead see
a whale as we think could not tell for certain
he was a great distance off. Fair wind steering
N by E Capt came on board fixed top sail
doubled reefed top sail fixed chain sail squared
in the fog is nearly as bad as rain evening a
light in the rigging at night here good breeze
In at reef out of chain top sail washed of some
ship there this night washed of see another ship
towing out run close to her and sent on board
it had the Wind of Log Hook got one
